KISS THEM DEADLY was away alertly and soon clear, then was pressured from the outside and inside by the seven sixteenths while in the two path, then duelled for command by the five sixteenths to the inside of FACTOR U AND ME IN came three off the bend and continued that duel and edged clear nearing the sixteenth marker to prove best under a drive. FACTOR U AND ME IN pressed the pace from the outside and made a three wide bid to duel with the winner three wide and came four wide off the bend but was out-kicked in the final furlong. KANTKNOWITALL was ridden along early to press the issue from the inside, fell back on the turn and moved off the rail, came five wide off the bend and moved farther out in the lane and faded.

LADY LEMONCELLO was allowed to settle along the inside, moved out on the turn and advanced two wide by the quarter pole, swung out five wide leaving the turn and ran on to gain the place award late. GOLDEN DANCER tracked the dueling leaders three wide, made a three to four wide bid by the quarter pole but flattened out in the lane and lost the place award late. ROYALTIESPRINCESS was settled early on the outside, four to five wide on the turn and came seven wide off the bend and improved late. MISS YOUNG LADY was squeezed back at the break, settled between rivals by the half mile marker and lacked a serious rally. MO JUICE dueled for the lead on the inside and was empty in the lane. YELENA BELOVA broke in at the break, tracked the pace from the outside and was four wide on the turn and weakened.
