GINGERSAYSCHILL was settled early, split rivals by the five sixteenths, came four wide into the lane and finished well. QUERCUS dueled for the lead to the outside of the winner, came four wide off the turn and fought on but was out-kicked while saving the the show award. QUERY was a bit fractious in the gate, bobbled at the break, was well placed on the inside, then faded in the lane. AVRIL was settled early, advanced on the inside, came three wide off the bend and flattened out. MISS SMARTY Z failed to menace. PRINCESS JESSICA was fractious in the gate, chased the pace on the outside and tired. FIFTY NINE FIFTY was reluctant to load, then was off very slowly and never factored.

MELODIOUS SINGER was reluctant to load, then was prominent early towards the inside, then steadied when trying to move to the outside of the pace setter, then stalked that rival and made a three wide bid on the turn to be clear by the quarter pole, then drew off in the lane to prove much the best under mild crop urging. BLAME CATALAYA tracked the leaders from the inside, eased off the inside nearing the quarter pole, came four wide into the lane and proved to be no match for the winner while being clearly second best. KELLY'S PARTY GIRL was reluctant to load, settled early and advanced on the inside on the turn, but lacked the needed winning bid while besting the rest. EARLY FROST was reserved early, saved ground on the turn and improved late to finish on even terms for the last spot for the superfecta. TALK MUCH set the pace and crossed over to the inside, then was headed on the turn, came two wide off the turn and weakened. LA RUNA chased the pace on the outside and was four wide on the turn and weakened. ZIFFY BUG was settled four wide and had no rally. BETWEEN DREAMS chased the early pace from between rivals and weakened.

WAHOOWA WAHOOWA was well placed on the inside throughout, made a inside bid leaving the turn and was put to A LONG DRIVE AND WAS CLEAR AT THE WIRE. SUGAR'S LAST HOPE stumbled at the break, vied for the early lead to the inside, then made a bid on the turn to draw clear by the quarter pole, came two to three wide off the bend and was outfinished. HENRYTHETHIRD was allowed to settle on the inside, then finished well on the inside. BERMONDSEY was reserved early, advanced four wide by the quarter pole, came five wide into the lane and had a mild rally but needed more. OVER AND THUNDER was four wide into the first turn, vied for the lead three wide and weakened. GIVE IT A GO was taken back early and was wide on the backstretch and passed the tiring rivals. CAUGHTANDCOLLECTED chased the pace on the outside and was five to six wide on the far turn and had no rally. TEXTPECTATION was off slowly and never factored. ELVIRUS was four wide into the first turn, chased the early pacer and then dropped back and made way to the inside on the far turn and tired. KBCYA LATER tracked the pace three wide and stopped. PELOSI tracked the pace three wide early, then was three to two wide on the turn, came three wide off the bend and kept on willingly and was gaining late but lost the place bob on the wire. RED BETTY chased the early pace on the inside, moved out on the turn and came four wide into the lane, angled out to the far outside and had a late surge but was too late. MY HUNNY BUNNY chased the early pace two wide, then saved ground into the lane and was slowly gaining and angled out late for racing room and kept on but needed more. BAINBRIDGE DANCER was bumped at the break, settled back early, came four wide into the lane, angled out in the lane and had a belated rally. MARYVIC was off slowly, made a four wide move on the turn but weakened in the drive. HEAVENLY LADY was off slowly, then settled three to four wide on the turn and was not a threat. CHAMBER OF SECRETS had a inside trip and failed to menace.
