## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

DANGEROUS DRIVER was allowed to settle early, moved to the inside and advanced on the far turn, continued along the inside and had a rail rally to edged clear late to prove best, driving. ROCKET NIGHT vied for the early lead three wide, then shook clear and gained a short lead leaving the seven sixteenths and moved to the inside and was engaged by a rival leaving the five sixteenths and dueled with that rival and came three wide off the bend and turned back that challenged and shook clear leaving the furlong marker but could not hold off the winner and had to settle for second best. DONNELLY'S HOLLOW lunged at the start and trailed early, advanced along the inside on the far turn and swung out three wide leaving the turn and was along for the show award. BIRRAVINO BLVD was rated along towards the outside and made a four wide move on the far turn to duel for command by the quarter pole but flattened out in the final furlong, losing the show award. NAUGHTY SQUIDWARD was five wide into the first turn and stalked the pace four wide and fell back on the turn and weakened. ANNIHILATE 'EM was six wide into the first turn and raced on the far outside to have pursuit and remained wide and tired. KUZ IT'S CHILLY pressed the early pace and was in between rivals leaving the three eighths marker and tired. THE MAN TO SEE vied for the lead on the inside and gave way on the far turn.
