RUNNINGFORJOY set the early pace while in the two path, was well handled throughout and came four wide off the far turn and was sent down to kick away and then remained clear to the wire under a mild drive. WHERE'S MY CHEW was five wide into the first turn and stalked the pace four wide, made a three wide bid on the far turn but flattened out in the drive while staying on for the place award. NOTTURNO prompted the early pace three wide and then moved in to track the winner two wide entering the far turn and then fell back midway on the turn in the two path and then ran on again late. D'ORO LEMON was reserved early on the inside, made a four wide run nearing the quarter pole and came five wide off the bend and finished willingly but was out-kicked for the show award. MAX'S GLORY had an awkward break, chased the pace three wide and weakened. HEAT ALERT chased the pace on the inside and tired.
