FISTFULOFMONEY stalked the pace on the turn, was set to an early drive leaving the five-sixteenths pole, commenced a steady rally inside the drifting pacesetter and finished well to be up in deep stretch and clear at the wire. SHEZ TWISTED sped off to a clear lead fifty yards away from the gate, opened a wide advantage while setting a rapid pace on the turn, drifted out turning for home and wandered greenly through the lane while still clear and was outkicked late in the drive while a clear second best. GO SIMPLE tracked the leaders to midway on the turn, was put to an all out drive nearing the quarter pole and flattened out in the lane unable to gain on the top pair. TEAR JERKER chased from five wide on the turn and was never a threat trailing throughout.

I'M HEADING EAST stalked the pacesetter to midway on the turn, rallied to be challenge from three wide leaving the quarter pole and wore down her rival in the lane to prevail late in a drive. WILD DELIGHT set the pace on a clear lead, responded well when engaged turning for home, battled through the lane and was outkicked in the final eighth while finishing gamely. OMIKAMI tracked the leader through the turn and failed to mount a closing rally in the stretch. UPPITY UP went evenly failing to menace. LIGHT HEARTED broke through the gate pre-race while well held by the assistant starter, lunged and hopped when the gates opened for real, chased the leaders down the backside and faded the victim of her antics at the start.

GRANDE TORTUGON (CHI) stalked the pace to the head of the lane, rallied in the three path inside the drifting pacesetter and prevailed in the final sixteenth. SAMURAI LEGACY sped to the lead shortly from the gate, opened a clear, comfortable lead through the turn, drifted out through the lane tiring and was caught inside the eighth pole in game effort. VELOCE unhurried in the early going to be near the rear, circled wide coming for home and made a steady rally down the lane to be up for the show. CON ON THE RUN tracked the leaders to the head of the stretch and lacked a closing rally finishing evenly. EXTRA MEDIUM raced mid-pack down the backstretch, rallied from five wide briefly on the turn to contention and flattened out in the drive. GUACO broke a step tardy to be at the rear of the field and never posed a threat. OLDZFOURFORTYTWO was not a factor.

DOMINANT STRANGER stalked the pacesetter to the turn, gradually reeled that tiring one in, cut the corner turning for home while talking command, opened a clear advantage in upper stretch and held well through the lane. RUNAWAY BREEZE reserved off the pace near the rear of the pack, rallied leaving the quarter pole with a steady gain to be up for the place on the wire. WILD LOOKER tracked the leaders from the inside saving ground and rallied up the fence in the lane to just miss the place. DOWN TO EARTH well placed on the turn gaining striking position, chased the winner in upper stretch and flattened out in the final eighth. STELLARATOR was a bit unprepared at the start, breaking awkwardly and was never a threat from there. TUDOR PEAK sped to a clear lead to the turn, drifted out on the bend tiring and gave way through the lane.
