CLASS PHOTO broke well to be first away, was taken in hand to settle to a stalking position on the first turn, rallied on the far turn to engage the pacesetter turning for home and drew away through the lane while wandering about. BARTULIA set the pace on a clear lead to the final turn, responded on the bend when challenged by the winner, was no match for that one and kept on willingly through the stretch as second best. EXPRESS STAR slow early to be well off the pace, was niggled on down the backside to keep pace, gained ground to the pack on the turn while saving ground, cut the corner and was along for the show. PARTNER TOURS reserved off the pace for the first five-eighths, rallied five wide on the turn and finished with mild interest on the outside in the lane. COLONEL POPPY tracked the leaders from the inside to the far turn and failed to respond when called upon. THIRD CITY reared at the start, settled into stride to race mid-pack from four wide through the first turn, continued wide down the backside making a brief bid on the final bend and flattened out.

THIS LAUGHS ON YOU set a pressured pace to the top of the lane, dug-in repelling the bid of BOUJIE BETZ in mid-stretch and kicked away gamely to hold the runner-up safe. CROWNING PRINCE tracked the leaders from the inside into the turn, was called upon on the bend to keep position, angled four wide in upper stretch and finished well when clear in the lane. BOUJIE BETZ pressed the pace for the first half, rallied to engage the leader midway down the lane and hung in the final eighth. PALACE REVOLT broke alertly, settled to chase the pace from six wide down the backside, remained wide on the turn and finished with some late interest. DOUBLE UP LARRY hopped at the start giving the field several lengths to trail to late in the lane having never been a factor. WARRIOR'S MISSION tracked the pace from three wide, rallied on the turn from between rivals to be prominent under a drive at the quarter pole and gave way in the lane when tiring. HURRICANES ABLOWIN dwelt at the start, walked out of the gate sideways long after the field was gone and galloped home having been distanced.

SANPIRODU in hand early to be off the pace, made a sweping bid four wide to engage the leaders at the quarter pole, kicked clear midway down the lane and dug-in to hold the runner-up safe in deep stretch. SHOWDOWN KING reserved along the fence for the run down the backside, was called upon midway on the bend to rally angling out four wide turning for home, tipped back to the inside in the lane to mount a good bid in the final eighth but was denied by the winner while a clear second best in a good effort. DISCO CENTS prompted the early pace, made a bid from between rivals at the quarter pole, battled with the winner in upper stretch and was outfinished through the lane. I'M THE CABANA BOY passed tiring rivals without impact. CHANGE THE HOUR showed brief speed to be in early contention and faded. OSBIN sped to the lead and gave way coming home.

GATITA SUAVE stalked the pace from the fence in a clear pocket into the turn, angled around the pacesetters nearing the quarter pole, drifted six wide at the head of the lane to challenge for the lead, drifted in to the four path in upper stretch causing rivals to the inside to be a bit crowded and finished determinedly to prevail at the wire. LA CREMA unhurried in the early going to be at the rear of the field, commence a bid midway on the turn splitting rivals in the four path turning for home, was crowded by the drifting winner while never breaking stride midway down the lane and battled to the wire to just miss. ANGEL OF HARLEM prompted the pace to the turn, rallied three wide at the quarter pole, failed to get passed the leaders in upper stretch, steadied leaving the eighth pole and finished evenly. EASY SEVEN sped to the a clear lead setting a rapid tempo and weakened in upper stretch. KAGERO broke slow to give the field several lengths at the start, hustled up to the pack in the first quarter and flattened out turning for home. THE RIDER OF THE RUNNER-UP CLAIMED FOUL FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH NEARING THE EIGHTH POLE, UPON REVIEW THE STEWARDS MADE NO CHANGE.
