RICHIESINTHEHOUSE was well rated on a well measured pace in hand, kicked clear when called upon in the lane and was never seriously threatened. LIGHTNING CHARLIE tracked the leader into the turn from the fence, cut the corner in tight quarters turning for home and rallied willingly along the rail in the lane while unable to cut into the winner's margin. SUMMERFEST unhurried early to trail, circled five wide on the turn to be prominent in mid-stretch and finished well while outkicked for the place. ERLAN reserved off the pace down the backside, was called upon early on the turn and showed some mild interest while failing to have an impact. YADI prompted the pace to the turn, chased the pacesetter in a drive through the turn and faded in the stretch. OSPREY was well placed stalking the pace from the fence on the backstretch, dropped back on the turn and was never a threat from there.

MR. COLOSSAL stalked the pace from four wide down the backstretch after moving to position leaving the first turn, rallied four wide on the far turn, engaged the leader midway down the lane and pulled clear late in the drive. AND THATS MY STORY circled four wide on the first turn to take the lead, set a well rated pace, responded when called upon turning for home and gave way to the winner grudgingly through the stretch drive. CRACKING CONNOR unhurried early to be at the back of the compact field, circled six wide coming for home and was gaining ground while grinding through the lane. KY THIRTY WON made a steady advance from the back of the field nearing the half mile pole to be prominently palced turning for home, loomed to mid-stretch and flattened out late unable to sustain the bid. THE FED'S PLOT tracked the leaders to the far turn and faded from contention coming home. SOCK IT TO ME prompted the pace for five-eighths and tired on the final bend giving way in the stretch.

LIZZIE BABY set the pace under constant pressure through dawdling fractions, repelled all challengers turning for home and kicked away through the lane in a well handled ride. PEACHES POINT well placed along the fence at the rear of a compact group, waited for racing room on the turn, angled four wide to the clear in upper stretch bumping rival and rallied mildly to be along for the place. NELIDA raced up splitting rivals down the backstretch to press the pace nearing the half mile pole, continued to press the winner to upper stretch and weakened in the lane. AIN'T NO LADY stalked the pace from three wide through the far turn, fanned out for the drive, was bumped by PEACHES POINT in upper stretch and flattened out. JASMINES WORLD pressed the pace for the first half mile, lost position into the far turn and finished evenly at the rear of the field.
