TANGO ZULU stalked the pace from four wide down the backside, made a mild bid on the far turn, could not reel in the winner and finished evenly to just hold the show. CRYSTAL WATER slow early to be the trailer to the far turn, circled eight wide coming home and made a belated rally in the lane. SENSIBLE MARRIAGE raced along the fence tracking the leaders down the backside, saved ground on the final turn and lacked a closing kick in the drive. CEFALU (FR) went evenly failing to mount a bid. SILENT DIVA rallied between rivals down the backside to be prominent on the final bend and flattened out unable to sustain the rally. SUSANOO was not a threat. DAME MAUDE CHARDIN was rank into the first turn and was never a factor.
