# Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

KEEP IN TOUCH set the pace on a clear lead, dug-in turning for home when called upon to maintain the advantage to midway down the lane and held the closers safe while tiring late. DOWN IN THE BAYOU unhurried to be near the rear of the field turning for home, mounted a good stretch rally splitting rivals and was gaining in deep stretch. MRS. MANICOTTI prompted the pace through the turn chasing the winner, failed to gain ground in mid-stretch and kept-on willingly to be closing late in a good try. TRIPLE SECRET was slow early racing at the rear of the field, circled coming home and closed well with a belated rally. DAISY JONES stalked the pace to the top of the lane and lacked a closing kick. LILY'S TIME tracked the leaders through the turn, angled seven wide to make a threatening bid in upper stretch and flattened out late. JOYS OF SUMMER passed tiring rivals. TOVIA raced in contention from between rivals four wide on the turn, was prominent midway down the lane and faded late. BELLA VOCE failed to menace putting in a dull effort. PERFECT PINK showed some early speed to be mid-pack and gave way down the lane.
