CAT ONE set a pressured pace to the quarter pole, responded when called upon turning for home and kicked away in the lane unthreatened. OLD FASHIONED GIRL stalked the pace from the inside down the backstretch, angled four wide rallying at the quarter pole to loom at the top of the lane, could not match the winner and finished willingly to take the place. TRAUMARAMA pressed the pace for three quarters, failed to pass at the quarter pole and ran-on through the lane. BOURBON BLAST trailed early, steadily advanced through the field to the far turn and mounted a belated bid from five wide down the stretch to be gaining late. PATH TO VICTORY was well placed in mid-pack throughout and failed to mount a closing rally. FLASHY TOO raced four wide into the first turn near the rear of the field and was one-paced from there. KRABI raced in tight quarters on the first turn having to be steadied, ranged up on the backstretch to track the leaders and faded on the far turn.
