GET EVEN took control from the gate setting a pressured, well measured pace to the head of the lane, kicked clear in upper stretch while drifting out when called upon and held well through the lane. EXTRA MEDIUM slow early to be the trailer well off the back of the pack, circled five wide turning for home and made a steady gain to garner the place. GROWTH CAPITAL stalked the pace from the inside to the five-sixteenths pole, angled out four wide mounting a bid at the quarter pole, cut back to the inside of the drifting winner and closed with a grinding bid to just miss the place. OUR ETHAN CHARLES tracked the leaders into the turn, lost ground on the bend and put in a mild bid in the stretch having to be briefly held up nearing the sixteenth pole and had no impact. GRANDE TORTUGON (CHI) pressed the pace to the quarter pole, failed to gain while remaining prominent to mid-stretch and weakened late.
