## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

VAN rated in mid-pack while well placed saving ground along the rail, cut the corner turning for home, rallied along the fence in the lane sneaking through an opening late in the drive to prevail. TAP THE SKY prompted the pace down the backstretch, continued to pursue the pacesetter down the lane, wore that one down late and was outkicked by the surging winner. GUNS N' ROJAS unhurried early to travel near the rear of the field, rallied leaving the quarter pole splitting rivals turning for home and finished well to be gaining late. FLAWLESS BOURBON set the pace on a clear, well rated lead, responded when called upon to battle to mid-stretch and weakened inside the eighth pole. YADI slow early to be the trailer to the quarter pole and showed good interest passing rivals in the stretch. TOMMY BEE stalked the pace from between rivals to the far turn, made a mild bid on the bend and lost ground through the stretch. ERLAN tracked the pace frome three wide to the far turn, was set to an early drive and faded failing to respond. CLASSIC KING failed to menace. MARSAC was caught wide racing mid-pack to the final bend and faded.
