EXCLUSIVE ENTRY set the pace opening a clear lead down the backside, maintained control through the turn, quickly spurted away in upper stretch and was never seriously threatened. THUNDER CANE reserved off the pace down the backside, saved ground on the turn while closing the gap and rallied well along the inside in the lane to gain the place. IMPOSTER SYNDROME was well placed tracking the leader from two wide through the turn, rallied turning for home drifting out, wandered about through the lane and was outfinished for the place. STEELER MISCHIEF rated in mid-pack while caught wide down the backside, was set to an early drive on the trun and made a grinding bid to be along for the show. TWELVETWO unhurried to be near the rear of the field, rallied along the inside turning for home and squeezed through along the fence showing some late interest. PALACE REVOLT tracked the leaders to be in striking distance at the quarter pole and lacked a closing rally. BIGONZETTI stalked the winner down the backside from four wide, narrowed the gap a bit on the turn, was no match and flattened out in upper stretch. RAGS SPECIAL was not a factor. RIDGE WARRIOR raced in contention for the first quarter and began a steady fade on the bend.
