GRAND MORNING pressed the pace into the first turn, was carried wide on the bend by the pacesetter, angled in off that one's heels to move to press the new leader, dueled with that one to mid-stretch and was outkicked in the final sixteenth. LIBRARY raced mid-pack down the backside, lost position around the final turn and re-bid showing some late interest in the lane. MAGNUS EFFECT took the lead into the first turn, raced six wide on the lead carrying rival out through the turn, settled off the pace to prompt down the backside while racing even wider in the eight path, angled in saving a bit of ground on the far turn still racing six wide to mount a challenge again for the lead in mid-stretch and weakened inside the final furlong.
