GRAND MORNING tracked the runaway pacesetter from a clear pocket to the far turn, rallied on the bend to take the lead turning for home and pulled clear in the final eighth. LIBRARY reserved off the quick pace in mid-pack for three-quarters, commenced a steady rally midway on the final turn and finished willingly to be up for the show. DOMINATOR C. unhurried early to be well off the pace, made a steady advance to narrow the gap and was gaining late. MAGNUS EFFECT stalked the pacesetter to the far turn, mounted a bid on the bend to take the lead at the quarter pole, drifted out through the lane while weakening to finish evenly. HONOR FOR MANDIN passed tiring rivals. HUNDRED PROOF went evenly failing to menace. STAND UP CHARLIE checked briefly down the stretch the first time to be the traailer and was never a threat. SO GRAND sped to the lead, opened a clear lead setting a fast pace, widened the advantage down the backside and came up empty on the final bend. EL ADIVINO was through after a half fading to the rear.
