DOMINANT STRANGER hustled to the lead shortly away from the gate, opened a clear lead in the first turn, was well rated while widenening the advantage to the far turn and held on with a dimishing margin through the lane. VANILLA BEAN was unhurried for a half to be the trailer, gained ground through the turn, angled to the inside in upper stretch and finished well with a belated bid. NEXT EPISODE tracked the runaway leader to midway on the final turn and made a steady advance coming home while unable to get passed. LA PANDA reserved well off the pace down the backstretch and rallied mildly while circling the field. LIZZIE BABY saved ground in mid-pack through the turn, angled out in upper stretch and showed some interest without impact. HIGHLAND HOLIDAY was well placed for a half mile and came up empty dropping to the rear.
