ADDY'S LADDY T N T, well placed stalking the pace while saving ground, eased out with a run near the quarter pole, straightened three to four wide into the lane, moved up between rivals then wrested command a furlong out, responded to right handed encouragement and drew clear. REMEMBERING WILBUR prompted the pace outside NORMANDY HERO, moved to attack into the turn, dueled, gained a slim past the five sixteenths, dug in when confronted nearing mid stretch and stayed on gamely to the wire.
