CEE'S THE IMAGE allowed to settle in the early stages while never far back, tracked the moderate pace outside of runners into the turn, roused four to five wide into the stretch, loomed at the furlong marker then took command past mid-stretch, kicked clear into the final sixteenth and drew away under mild hand urging in the late stages. IRISH PRANCER showed speed away from the start, went up and prompted the moderate pace outside of HAPPY CHAPPY approaching the half-mile pole, pressed three wide into the turn, vied for the lead into upper stretch and took a narrow advantage at the furlong marker, overtaken past mid-stretch, could not keep pace with the winner into the final sixteenth and was second best. PONDERGATING tracked the early pace from the second flight, chased between runners into the turn and ran in pursuit from the two path nearing the quarter pole, got caught in tight into upper stretch, shifted out and found room at the furlong marker, needed more into the final sixteenth but stayed on to earn the nod for third. LEEDSTHESKY tracked the moderate early pace from the outside, was well placed while three to four wide into the turn, bid between runners into the stretch, could not sustain her run into the final sixteenth and just missed for third on the wire. HAPPY CHAPPY broke alertly and assumed early command, set moderate fractions while prompted heading to the half-mile marker, disputed the moderate pace into the turn, was overtaken into upper stretch, chased to the furlong marker and stopped in the late stages.

SUPERMAZEL settled off of the early pace, tracked the leading pair along the first turn and was well placed into the backstretch run, roused four to five wide into the far turn, loomed into upper stretch and took command at the furlong marker, drew clear into the final sixteenth, drifted in deep stretch, recovered and held for the win over his oncoming stablemate. BIG SPIN was leaning at the start then was away slowly from the gate, unhurried in the early stages, content to trail through the backstretch run, roused two wide into the far turn, got caught a bit in tight at the quarter pole and swung four to five wide into upper stretch, chased to the furlong marker, closed willingly into the final sixteenth, gained second in deep stretch but could not reel in his stablemate for the win. ITS THIEVERY broke alertly, took back off of the early pace and settled into the first turn, saved ground while unhurried through the backstretch, saved all of the ground into the far turn, advanced at the quarter pole and loomed into upper stretch, was outkicked into the final sixteenth and held clearly late for third. UPSTART YANKEE prominent away from the start, vied for the early lead inside of KITTEN'S KID, took a slim lead into the backstretch run and set a prompted pace heading to the half-mile pole, dug in into the far turn and led nearing the quarter marker, battled into upper stretch, was overtaken approaching the furlong grounds and gave way in the late stages. KITTEN'S KID vied for the early lead outside of UPSTART YANKEE, ceded the lead into the backstretch run and prompted that rival through moderate fractions heading to the half-mile pole, pressed the pace three wide into the far turn, was outkicked into upper stretch and faded in the final furlong.

BROADWAY TIGER sent to take command leaving the start, set a moderate pace heading to the half-mile marker, showed the way into the turn and set the decent pace while off of the rail nearing the quarter pole, set down into upper stretch, led to the furlong marker and dug in past mid-stretch, felt pressure from the oncoming TWILIGHT EMPIRE into the final sixteenth, was all out into deep stretch and lasted at the finish for a determined win. TWILIGHT EMPIRE was bothered by a neighboring rival at the start and broke a step slowly, settled off of the early pace while never far back, raced outside of rivals into the turn, gained ground four wide at the quarter marker and sustained that bid into the stretch, responded while widest into the final furlong, confronted BROADWAY TIGER at the sixteenth-marker, was closing on the winner with every stride into deep stretch and just missed for the win, while well clear of the rest for second. TAMANTARI close up away from the start, ceded the early lead to BROADWAY TIGER and stalked the moderate pace from between rivals heading to the half-mile pole, chased between runners into the turn, was outkicked in the stretch drive and held well in the late stages for third. HONORABLE GAL prominent away from the start, came under a snug early hold and tracked the moderate pace from the inside heading to the half-mile pole, saved ground into the turn and chased the pace nearing the quarter marker, maintained an inside path into the stretch and could not muster the needed late response. QUEEN MOLOTOV stumbled at the start, bothered a neighboring rival and was off slowly, initially settled off of the early pace then rushed up to press the pace outside of BROADWAY TIGER, chased three wide into the turn, could not keep pace into upper stretch and faded in the drive.

FULL MOON GRAZEN lacked speed away from the start and trailed in the early stages, saved ground into the turn and improved position at the quarter pole, made a steady advance through the stretch drive and was a clear third at the finish. HOPING SHE WILL a step slow away from the start, hustled in the early stages, assumed command and set a decent pace nearing the half-mile marker, set the pace into the turn then was pressed along the bend by NEPELE, was overtaken into upper stretch, chased to the furlong marker and gave way in the late stages. CLASSY DOE settled off of the decent early pace, went widest into the turn and chased four to five wide nearing the quarter pole, swung widest into upper stretch and ran evenly to the furlong marker, could not muster a late response and did not threaten in the final sixteenth. VICTORIA'S CHARGE sent leaving the start, showed good early speed and set the pace heading to the half-mile marker, dictated terms into the turn and set decent fractions while off of the rail nearing the quarter pole, drew clear into upper stretch, was ridden out past mid-stretch and drew off in the late stages to win as much the best. VELOCIOUS prominent away from the start, stalked the decent early pace outside of VICTORIA'S CHARGE, chased the pacesetter three wide into the turn, could not keep pace with the winner into the stretch and held well in the final stages for the place honors. ACE ACE BABY stalked the decent early pace from the inside, saved ground into the turn and chased the pacesetter from the rail nearing the quarter pole, outkicked into upper stretch, battled VELOCIOUS for the place honors into the final sixteenth and missed for second, while well clear of the rest for third. READY TO GIG rated off of the decent early pace, was well placed approaching the turn and tracked from the inside heading to the quarter pole, shifted two wide into upper stretch, was outkicked at the furlong marker and lacked a late response. HOT BETTY settled off of the decent early pace while never far back, chased two to three wide and between rivals along the turn, was outrun nearing the quarter pole and did not threaten in the stretch drive. ICY MISCHIEF broke in at the start and was off a bit slowly, rushed up between rivals and was forwardly placed nearing the half-mile pole, chased three to four wide into the turn, lost ground at the quarter marker, could not keep pace into the stretch and gave way. TOM'S TREASURE forwardly placed while between runners in the early stages, took back nearing the half-mile marker and trailed into the turn, was guided three to four wide approaching the quarter pole and did not offer a response in the stretch drive.
