SAHARA SUE unhurried from the start, advanced steadily down the backstretch, circled the field through the turn, came about four wide into the stretch and finished strong under steady handling to be along in time. SMOOVE AS SILK broke well and stalked the pacesetting PINEAPPLE CRUISE to the turn, went to challenge for the lead near the three-furlong pole, found that foe resilient, got the best of that one with a furlong to go but was passed late by the winner. JULIET'S KITCHEN broke well and was up with the leaders in the initial stages, then steadied near the five-furlong pole when a couple of rivals converged and took the path, regrouped in a tracking position then started to run on from the five-sixteenths pole and finished willingly to gain third. PINEAPPLE CRUISE was sent hard from the outside for the lead and took the field to the turn, fought back when confronted by SMOOVE AS SILK from the three-furlong marker then gave way grudgingly in the final furlong. STANDFORGRIT was rank after exiting the starting gate then taken out in the clear about six wide, by that time spotting the field several lengths, settled down but continued to race wide through the turn, came six wide into the stretch and passed a couple of stragglers in the late stages. HARBOR DEAREST was allowed to settle from the break and was near the back of the pack down the backstretch, was stuck behind horses through the turn then did not rally once clear in the stretch. GENTLE JULIA tracked close up from the inside to the turn, weakened near the five-sixteenths pole and had little to offer in the stretch.

UNPRETENTIOUS a step slow leaving the start, rushed up and was forwardly placed in the early stages, tracked the moderate pace outside of rivals heading to the half-mile pole, advanced into the turn, loomed three wide at the quarter pole and vied for the lead into upper stretch, exchanged bumps with GOIN' SOUTH at the three-sixteenths marker, dueled that rival to mid-stretch, repelled the runner-up nearing the sixteenth-marker and drew clear in the late stages under moderate hand urging. GOIN' SOUTH prominent away from the start, went up and prompted the moderate early pace heading to the half-mile pole, pressed the pace into the turn and vied for the lead at the quarter pole, met the bid of UNPRETENTIOUS into upper stretch then exchanged bumps with that rival at the three-sixteenths, battled to mid-stretch, could not match strides with the winner into the final sixteenth and stayed on to be second best at the finish. SOUTHERN TORNADO settled off of the moderate early pace, chased two wide into the turn, shifted three wide at the quarter pole, outrun into upper stretch, stayed on into the final sixteenth and got up in the final strides for third. SWIFT STEPHAN away in good order, raced close up to the early pace, well placed approaching the turn and chased two wide and between runners into the bend, outrun into upper stretch, needed more into the final sixteenth and was outfinished for third. MAGILLIGAN hustled away from the start, assumed early command and set a contested pace approaching the half-mile pole, disputed the pace from the inside into the turn, dueled GOIN' SOUTH nearing the quarter pole, could not keep pace into the stretch and faded in the final furlong. RAGAZZONE fractious in the gate, was crowded then bumped by an inner rival and away slowly, trailed approaching the half-mile pole, saved ground into the turn and improved position at the quarter marker, swung widest into the stretch and passed tiring rivals late. NO ORDINARY TIGER broke out at the start, bothered a neighboring rival and was off a bit slowly, tracked the moderate early pace from between runners, got caught in tight approaching the turn and was shuffled back at the three-eighths, lacked a response into the stretch and tired. SHOT CLOCK chased the moderate early pace from the inside, saved ground into the turn, was outrun to the quarter pole and came up empty in the stretch. COUSIN THEO a step slow away from the start, chased the moderate early pace from between runners, ran in pursuit three wide into the turn, was outrun to the quarter pole and gave way in the stretch. THE RIDER OF GOIN' SOUTH LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE RIDER OF UNPRETENTIOUS FOR INTERFERENCE IN UPPER STRETCH. THE STEWARDS RULED IN A UNANIMOUS DECISION THAT NO CHANGE WOULD BE MADE.

PATSY MONTANA rated nicely leaving the start, tracked the decent early pace from the second flight approaching the half-mile pole, saved ground into the turn and loomed nearing the quarter marker, maintained an inside path into the lane and vied for the lead heading to mid-stretch, took command past the furlong marker, repelled STYLISH DRESS into the final sixteenth and held safely in a drive at the finish. TOPPER'S CHIEFTESS broke awkwardly leaving the start and spotted the field to begin, allowed to settle in the early stages, advanced into the turn and tracked the decent pace between runners nearing the quarter pole, mounted a three wide bid into the stretch and came within range approaching the furlong grounds, was outkicked by the winner into the final sixteenth but stayed on in deep stretch and got up late for second. STYLISH DRESS forwardly placed away from the start, stalked the decent early pace inside of rivals heading to the half-mile pole, chased two wide and between runners along the turn, tipped three wide into upper stretch and took command at the three-sixteenths, was confronted at mid-stretch by PATSY MONTANA, battled that rival into the final sixteenth, could not keep pace with the winner into deep stretch, was overtaken late for second and was well clear of the rest for third. ACHROMATIC allowed to settle away from the start, gained ground two wide at the quarter pole, ran evenly to mid-stretch, needed more into the final sixteenth and passed tiring rivals late. RIVER OF

AMBITION forwardly placed away from the start, tracked the decent early pace from between rivals, well placed approaching the turn, chased the pace four to five wide nearing the quarter pole, was outkicked into the stretch and weakened in the final stages. KEEPYOURPRANCEON was squeezed at the start and broke a bit slowly, lacked early speed, trailed into the turn, went four wide nearing the quarter pole, swung six wide into upper stretch, needed more into the final sixteenth and passed tiring rivals late. LADY WOLF broke alertly, vied for the early lead with GALWAY SHAWL then ceded the front to that rival, stalked outside of GALWAY SHAWL approaching the half-mile pole, chased the pace three to four wide into the turn, lost position into the stretch and faded late. GALWAY SHAWL showed good early speed leaving the start, assumed command and set a decent pace heading to the half-mile pole, showed the way into the turn and held a clear lead at the quarter pole, was overtaken into upper stretch, could not keep pace into the final stages and gave way. CONQUEST SECRET tracked the decent early pace from the second flight, chased three wide into the turn, lost position at the quarter marker and did not factor in the late stages.
