

CANDY'S WILDCAT broke well and was on the outside of a five horse pace battle, went on from the half mile marker with RED SVEN, dueled that foe to the quarter pole while confidently ridden, opened up at the top of the stretch and drew away late. IM GUNNA was widest of all in the early pace battle then dropped back with three furlongs to go, continued wide into the stretch and finished well, was no threat to the winner but clearly second best. GETEMDUSTY broke a step slow and spotted the field a bit of a head start, then advanced the backstretch, launched a bid near the seven-sixteenths pole, circled the field, came into the stretch five to six wide and rallied strongly down the middle of the track to gain the third position. ONE BIG SMILE vied inside in the early pace battle, dropped back to a stalking position on the turn, drifted out before the run for home then re-rallied under steady handling, loomed a threat to mid-stretch the finished evenly. SON O' SANPETE was slow to get into stride then advanced into contention with heading into the turn, came five wide into the stretch and finished with CANDY'S WILDCAT past the half-mile pole, dueled that foe to the quarter pole then was unable to go on and weakened in the stretch. SCIENCE RULES lacked early speed and tracked well behind the pace battle, lacked a rally and never a factor. TRIANGLE was last away, dropped far back early, was kept to task and passed a couple in deep stretch. RUN BABA RUN paused at the start and was a step slow to begin, recovered and saved ground while not far back in the early going, tracked the moderate pace inside of runners along the backstretch, chased from the inside into the second turn, bid between rivals into upper stretch, vied for the lead at the furlong pole, dueled while on even terms with FAR TO LONG into the final sixteenth, took a narrow lead into deep stretch and held gamely in the final stages. FAR TO LONG took back off of the early pace, was three wide into the first turn, advanced between rivals along the backstretch, roused three to four wide into the far turn, bid into upper stretch and vied for the lead approaching the furlong marker, dueled on even terms with RUN BABA RUN past mid-stretch, could not match strides with the winner into deep stretch and was well clear of the rest for second. RED RAJ settled off of the early pace, saved ground into the first turn, was unhurried through the backstretch, saved all of the ground into the second turn, mounted an inside bid into upper stretch, tipped two wide at the furlong marker and chased past mid-stretch, was outkicked into the final sixteenth and was well clear of the rest for third. BEGIN AGAIN sent leaving the start, took command into the first turn and set a moderate pace into the backstretch run, set a pressured pace nearing the half-mile marker, shook free into the far turn and maintained a clear lead at the quarter pole, was overtaken nearing the furlong grounds, could not keep pace past mid-stretch and gave way in the late stages. RIVER'S BENCHMARK broke alertly, ceded the early lead to BEGIN AGAIN, stalked outside of that rival into the first turn, pressed the moderate pace along the backstretch run, chased BEGIN AGAIN into the far turn, went three wide nearing the quarter pole, was outrun into upper stretch and tired in the final furlong. CRAZY STORM was forwardly placed away from the start, tracked the early pace four wide and between runners into the first turn, was well placed into the backstretch, stalked the moderate pace heading to the half-mile pole, chased three to four wide into the second turn, lacked a response into upper stretch and faded in the drive. EL BEARIN chased the early pace, was caught five to six wide into the first turn, maintained a wide path into the backstretch and chased the moderate pace heading to the half-mile pole, ran in pursuit six wide into the second turn, was outrun to the quarter pole and weakened in the stretch. BANDON GIG raced close up to the early pace, tracked three wide and between runners into



the first turn, lost position into the backstretch, trailed at the half-mile pole and was not a factor in the late stages.
