TOPANTICIPATION (GB) prominent leaving the start, prompted the moderate early pace outside of STATEFOREST, pressed the pace two to three wide along the turn, took command into upper stretch, dug in at the furlong grounds, kept to task into the final sixteenth and held in the late stages for a determined win. STATEFOREST sent to assume early command, set a pressured pace heading to the half-mile, dueled inside of TOPANTICIPATION into the turn, was overtaken by that rival into upper stretch, stubbornly stayed on into the final furlong and held well in deep stretch for second. YODERANDO bobbed at the start and was off a bit slowly, recovered and tracked the early pace inside of rivals, saved ground into the turn, made a steady advance to the top of the stretch, closed well into the final furlong, could not reel in the leading pair late and held well for third. A DIME FOR ME took back in the early stages, tracked outside of rivals heading to the half-mile pole, chased three to four wide along the turn, swung widest into upper stretch and lost a bit of ground at the furlong marker, mounted a late rally and just missed for third. HOLLYWOOD RUMOR rated just off of the early pace, tracked between runners heading to the half-mile pole, chased two to three wide and between rivals into the turn, raced within range into the stretch and was outkicked in the final sixteenth.

BIG BET broke well and bid for the lead with GUAGUARERO going into the first turn, then backed off to a stalking position in the three path and was content to sit just off the flank of that rival to the far turn, moved to challenge for the lead approaching the quarter pole, battled to mid-stretch, gained the advantage in the final furlong and won clear. CAUSE FOR DIVORCE tracked a few lengths behind the pacesetting pair, went into a sustained drive with three furlongs to run, was slowly gaining ground in the stretch, proved to menace to the winner but kept to task and gained second in the final yards. GUAGUARERO was hustled from the break and was first into the clubhouse turn with BIG BET just to the outside, was left to dictate the fractions down the backstretch two paths away from the rail while that rival remained a constant presence, responded under pressure when challenged at the quarter pole, battled gamely to mid-stretch then gave way and was unable to hold second. LATER TAMARTATER was slow into stride and lagged well behind the pace while allowed to settle, was asked to go on from the seven-sixteenths pole but could not improve in the stretch. SIBERIAN SLEW broke well but did not show any early speed, toiled at the rear of the field inside of LATER TAMARTATER to the half-mile pole, fell further behind through the turn and was eased in the stretch when hopelessly outrun.

CODE RIBBON allowed to settle away from the start, trailed in the early stages while never far back, was guided outside of runners approaching the turn, loomed three to four wide nearing the quarter pole, vied for the lead into upper stretch and took a narrow advantage at the furlong marker, kicked clear into the final sixteenth and was kept to task under mild urging in the late stages. A ROUSING BABE a step slow leaving the start, was hustled in the early stages and pressed the moderate pace outside of GETAWAY CHARM, disputed the pace three wide nearing the quarter pole, took command into upper stretch, was overtaken by CODE RIBBON at the furlong marker, could not match strides with the winner into the final sixteenth and held for second at the finish. GETAWAY CHARM sent leaving the start, assumed early command and set a pressured pace heading to the half-mile marker, contested the pace inside of A ROUSING BABE into the turn, dueled that rival to the quarter marker, was outkicked into upper stretch, stayed on into the final sixteenth and just missed for second, while holding clearly for third. GREATFUL ATTITUDE took back off of the early pace, shifted to the outside and tracked nearing the half-mile marker, chased three wide into the turn, lost position into upper stretch and lacked a late rally. THE GREAT HAYNES raced close up to the early pace, saved ground into the turn and chased to the quarter pole, could not keep pace into upper stretch and weakened. LADY'S SERMON broke alertly, ceded the early lead and tracked between rivals heading to the half-mile marker, chased two wide and between runners into the turn, was outrun at the quarter pole and did not threaten in the stretch drive.

I AM AMADEO close up in the early stages, took back and tracked the decent pace outside of rivals approaching the turn, mounted a three then four wide bid at the quarter pole, vied for the lead into upper stretch and took a narrow lead at the furlong marker, dug in while holding HERMELINDA'S FANCY at bay into the final sixteenth and determinedly lasted for the win in deep stretch. HERMELINDA'S FANCY sent leaving the start, showed good speed and disputed the decent early pace inside of HYDROPLANE, dueled through the turn and took a narrow lead at the quarter pole, met the bid of I AM AMADEO into upper stretch, lost the lead to that rival at the furlong marker, continued to battle into the final sixteenth, was bested by the determined winner and was clear of the rest for second. G G GILLEY forwardly placed to begin, chased the decent early pace from the inside, saved ground into the turn, was well placed nearing the quarter pole and ran in pursuit into upper stretch, battled into the final furlong, was outkicked in the final sixteenth and was clear for third. HYDROPLANE prominent in the early stages, engaged with HERMELINDA'S FANCY and disputed the decent early pace outside of that rival, pressed the pace three wide into the turn, lost ground into upper stretch and faded in the late stages. SOUTHERN BLESSING lacked early speed and trailed throughout.
