READY TO GIG rated nicely off of the decent early pace, well placed into the turn, was roused three to four wide into the stretch, took command and kicked clear at the furlong marker, was kept to mild urging into the final sixteenth and drew away as much the best in deep stretch. SELSAE allowed to settle away from the start, tracked the decent early pace from outside of runners, chased three to four wide nearing the quarter marker, ran in pursuit four to five wide into the stretch, was no match for the winner into the final sixteenth and was a clear second. CONQUEST SECRET sent to assume command leaving the start, set decent fractions while pressured to the half-mile marker, led into the turn and contested the pace with HOT BETTY nearing the quarter marker, was overtaken into upper stretch, chased READY TO GIG into the final furlong, faded in the drive and just held for third. HOT BETTY went up to press the decent early pace outside of CONQUEST SECRET, disputed the decent pace into the turn, went two to three wide nearing the quarter marker, was outkicked by READY TO GIG into upper stretch, lacked a response in the stretch drive, gave way and was outfinished for third.

QUIET CHARM a step slow leaving the start, settled off of the decent early pace while never far back, crowded THUNDER OF ZION nearing the three furlong pole, was well placed into the turn and loomed from the inside at the quarter marker, vied for the lead into upper stretch then took command approaching the furlong grounds, kept to task into the final sixteenth and held well in the late stages to prevail. ELCONDOR broke alertly and vied for the early lead from inside of rivals, disputed the decent pace off of the rail entering the turn, led into upper stretch then was overtaken by QUIET CHARM nearing the furlong marker, battled past mid-stretch, was kept at bay in the final sixteenth and held well late for second. CITY OF CHAMPIONS vied for the early lead between rivals, disputed the decent pace four deep nearing the half-mile pole, pressed four wide along the turn, lost ground into upper stretch, re-rallied into the final sixteenth and missed late for second. EDDIE CROSSWIRE raced close up to the early pace, chased outside of runners and ran in pursuit five wide into the turn, lost ground nearing the quarter marker, ran evenly while widest into upper stretch, closed the gap into the final sixteenth but was outfinished in the late stages. THUNDER OF ZION took back leaving the start, tracked the decent early pace while never far back, was crowded by QUIET CHARM approaching the turn then checked when that rival took his path at the three-eighths pole, chased two wide to the quarter marker, offered a mild rally in the stretch drive but needed more late. SEIGE THE DAY away in good order, vied for the early lead from between runners, pressed the decent pace three wide and between foes into the turn, could not keep pace into upper stretch and tired in the final furlong. AN OBJECTION WAS LODGED BY THE RIDER OF THUNDER OF ZION AGAINST THE RIDER OF QUIET CHARM FOR INTERFERENCE NEARING THE THREE-EIGHTHS POLE. THE STEWARDS DETERMINED THAT QUIET CHARM DID NOT COST THUNDER OF ZION THE OPPORTUNITY OF A BETTER PLACING AND THAT NO CHANGE WOULD BE MADE.

WARRENS WORLD broke alertly, ceded the early lead and settled off of the decent early pace while not far back, raced four wide into the turn and stalked the pace nearing the quarter pole, made a quick move to assume command into upper stretch, kicked clear at the furlong marker and was kept to task into the final sixteenth, felt a bit of pressure from the oncoming runner-up in the late stages and held safely at the finish. OH GREAT (IRE) got shuffled back a bit in the early stages and was unhurried in the opening quarter mile, trailed into the turn, went three to four wide nearing the quarter pole, rallied five wide into the stretch, closed willingly into the final sixteenth, could not reel in the winner in deep stretch and was a clear second. TITOS WITH A TWIST got shuffled back a bit in the early going and was allowed to settle in the opening stages, raced two to three wide into the turn and gained ground at the quarter pole, got caught a bit in tight into upper stretch and continued his gain at the furlong marker, could not match strides with the top pair into the final sixteenth but stayed on in deep stretch to earn the show honors. CONTINENTAL UNION vied for the early lead leaving the start, took back and tracked the decent early pace outside of runners, shifted to the inside approaching the turn, saved ground along the bend and was well placed nearing the quarter marker, lacked a response into the stretch and weakened. STORMIN GALILEO hustled leaving the start, assumed early command and set a decent pace while pressured to the half-mile marker, showed the way into the turn and dictated terms off of the rail nearing the quarter marker, was overtaken into upper stretch, chased to the furlong pole and tired in the late stages. LANGSTON ROAD chased the early pace from outside of rivals, went up and pressed STORMIN GALILEO heading to the half-mile marker, attended to the pace three wide into the turn, could not keep pace into upper stretch and gave way.

SUNSET GRAZEN close up away from the start, stalked the early pace two to three wide into the first turn, prompted the moderate pace through the backstretch run, pressed EMPRESS LORRAYNE into the far turn then took command into upper stretch, drew to a clear lead at the furlong marker, was ridden out past mid-stretch and drew off as much the best in the late stages. EMPRESS LORRAYNE sent to assume early command, set a prompted pace into the backstretch run, carved out moderate fractions while pressured into the second turn, overtaken by SUNSET GRAZEN into upper stretch, was no match for the winner in the stretch drive and held well for second in the final sixteenth.
