DRIVE BY sent leaving the start, engaged with BOBBY ANTON in the early going and disputed moderate fractions outside of that rival heading to the half-mile pole, pressed the pace two to three wide along the turn, lost ground into upper stretch, was outkicked in the stretch drive and held clearly for third. CONEJO MALO prominent away from the start, ceded the early lead and stalked inside of rivals heading to the half-mile marker, was guided to the outside and chased three to four wide into the turn, was outkicked into upper stretch, could not keep pace into the final furlong and weakened in deep stretch. WINTER SOLDIER slow into stride away from the start, saved ground into the turn and advanced at the quarter pole, finished evenly in the stretch and did not threaten late. TOP WOLF settled off of the early pace, was guided three wide into the turn and lost ground at the quarter pole, lacked a response into the stretch and was not a factor late.

HEAT N REHEAT was hustled from the break and contested the early pace into the first turn, ceded the lead to WIINTER FALCON before the backstretch run and dropped back to a stalking position on the inside, remained close through the far turn but had to idle a bit waiting for room, moved out to the two path approaching the quarter pole, loomed three wide at the top of the stretch then flattened out in the last furlong. TABLE FOR TEN lacked speed in the early stages and lagged behind the rest along with BIG SPIN, was asked for more passing the three furlong marker but did not respond, came three wide into the stretch and did not menace.

PONDERGATING away in good order, settled just off of the early pace and tracked from the inside heading to the half-mile marker, well placed into the turn, chased the pacesetter two wide nearing the quarter pole, tipped three wide into upper stretch, ran evenly while in pursuit approaching the furlong grounds, responded to urging and rallied past mid-stretch, took command inside of the sixteenth-marker and lasted for the win over the oncoming runner-up. SPREAD THE RISK bothered by a neighboring rival at the start, was jostled leaving the gate and was away slowly, settled off of the decent early pace, improved position two to three wide and between rivals along the turn, shifted four wide into the stretch, closed fast in the late stages, surged in deep stretch and just missed for the win, while holding safely for second. ALMOST GOT LUCKY was squeezed at the start and was off slowly, unhurried in the early stages, trailed into the turn and went two to three wide nearing the guarter marker, gained ground at mid-stretch, closed willingly into the final sixteenth and got up for third at the wire. RIVER OF AMBITION broke alertly and showed good speed away from the start, sprinted to a clear early lead and set the pace into the turn, carved out moderate fractions into the turn and led into upper stretch, was confronted by SMILIN RUBY and battled that rival while holding a narrow lead at the furlong marker, stubbornly fought on into the final sixteenth, yielded in deep stretch and just missed for third at the wire. SMILIN RUBY broke in at the start and bothered a neighboring rival, tracked the solid early pace three deep nearing the half-mile pole, chased three wide into the turn and was well placed approaching the quarter marker, vied for the lead into upper stretch, battled with RIVER OF AMBITION past mid-stretch, could not hold off oncoming rivals into the final sixteenth and was outkicked in deep stretch. GEEJAYTEE tracked the early pace from the second flight, saved ground into the turn and was outrun to the quarter marker, maintained an inside path into the stretch, was gaining in the final sixteenth but needed more in the late stages. JULIET'S KITCHEN tracked three wide through the turn, rallied into second in upper stretch then weakened late and surrendered that place to FLY SOUTH while finishing a good distance ahead of the next horse. CASILLALATER came away from the gate awkwardly, chased inside of the trailing group, held the rail through the turn, ran on some down the lane but could not threaten the top three. PATSY MONTANA broke well but was unable to keep up with the early pace, raced between horses in the trailing group through the early stages, was being put in tight and brushed a few times with HARBOR DEAREST through the turn, ran on a bit in the stretch but was unable to threaten. HARBOR DEAREST was outrun from the break, raced three wide at the rear of the field, brushed with PATSY MONTANA a couple of times through the turn, passed one at the top of the stretch but otherwise was not a factor in the late stages. HARBOR'S ROSE pressed the pace to the outside of BOBBY'S GENIE to the turn, started to struggle to keep up after passing the three furlong marker, came under pressure before the quarter pole, stopped and faded to last in the stretch.

GRUBAUER sent to assume early command, set a contested pace while well handled nearing the half-mile pole, showed the way while pressured into the turn, carved out moderate fractions nearing the quarter pole and battled CLEVER CLOVER into upper stretch, shook free from that rival at the furlong marker, kicked clear into the final sixteenth and was hand urged to the finish for a convincing win. MIO BAMBINO was crowded at the break and away slowly, allowed to settle in the early stages, improved position and chased five wide into the turn, well placed at the quarter marker, went three to four wide into the stretch and ran evenly to the furlong pole, was not able to impact the winner into the final sixteenth but stayed on into deep stretch and got up late for second. CLEVER CLOVER broke alertly, assumed the early lead then ceded to GRUBAUER and pressed inside of that rival heading to the half-mile marker, saved ground into the turn and disputed the moderate pace to the quarter pole, battled GRUBAUER into the stretch, was repelled at the furlong marker and chased four to final sixteenth, could not match strides with the winner into deep stretch and was tagged late for second, while holding clearly for third. EVERYDAYISSATURDAY tracked the moderate early pace from the second flight, chased between rivals into the turn, got shuffled back a bit at the three-eighths and chased four to five wide nearing the quarter marker, ran evenly to mid-stretch, could not muster the needed response in deep stretch and finished evenly. SATANTA allowed to settle in the early stages, trailed to the half-mile marker, improved position two to three wide along the turn, swung four wide for the stretch drive, finished evenly and passed firm rivals in the late stages. HOT CHICKS ONLY was forwardly placed away from the start, tracked the moderate early pace between rivals, chased firme the early pace heart and lost ground at the quarter pole, was outrun into the stretch and was well placed at the quarter pole, lost ground into upper stretch,

slowly and settled off of the moderate early pace, raced three wide into the turn, was outrun to the quarter marker and did not factor in the stretch drive. TALK ABOUT AUTISM tracked the early pace outside of rivals, was well placed into the turn, chased four wide and between rivals nearing the quarter marker, could not keep pace into the stretch and gave way in the final furlong.

HAPPY DOES was not asked for speed from the break, was last into the first turn and stayed three to four wide through that turn and down the backstretch, advanced on the leaders to the half, then, made a bid for the lead entering the far turn, emerged with the lead at the top of the stretch, took on a challenge from HERECOMEGEORGIEBOY, kept ahead of that foe under steady handling and intermittent urging and just held on at the wire. HERECOMEGEORGIEBOY was allowed to settle after the break, was unhurried through the first turn and was last heading on to the backstretch, raced five wide and followed HAPPY DOES as that one made a bid for the lead on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, chased that rival the length of the stretch under strong handling but could not get by. SEA OF LIBERTY got caught four wide into the first turn, advanced down the backstretch then put some pressure on the leader EFFECTIVE GIG from the half mile marker, was then joined by HAPPY DOES at the five-sixteenths pole, went into a drive but could not go on with that foe in the stretch, kept to task and held third. POUR ON THE COLE came away well from the outside post then raced just behind

EFFECTIVE GIG through the first turn and kept within a striking position down the backstretch, became boxed in through the whole of the far turn, got clear in the stretch but then lacked a rally, finished evenly. BIG FLAME was pushed on a bit from the break, and raced close up on the rail through the first turn, was pushed to get with the leaders down the backstretch and got close heading into the turn but then got stuck behind horses, went into a drive from the five-sixteenths but tired in the stretch, could not improve and was not persevered with in the final sixteenth. SUNNY SPOT broke well and was between horses early, was stuck behind a wall of horses down the backstretch and could not find a way through, went four wide through the far turn and came five wide into the stretch but could not summon a rally. EFFECTIVE GIG was hustled to the front from the break and seized the early lead going into the first bend, slowed the pace and maintained a length ahead the field to the half then was pressed to quicken by SEA OF LIBERTY at that point, then also joined by HAPPY DOES struggled to keep up at the faster pace, dropped out before the quarter pole and tired in the stretch. GALLANT WARREN was pushed to get orward position and was in the first flight of horses through the clubhouse turn, raced mid-pack down the backstretch then started to drop back when the pace quickened at the half mile marker, lost contact with the field heading into the turn and was not a factor from that point on.
