UPDRAFT was a step slow away from the start, allowed to settle in the early stages, raced two wide into the first turn, well placed into the backstretch run, made a middle move nearing the half-mile marker and vied three wide and between rivals at that station, took command into the second turn, battled DORADUS to the quarter pole, repelled that rival into upper stretch and kicked clear at the furlong marker, kept to task while clear into the final sixteenth, felt late pressure from the quickly oncoming runner-up and held in a drive at the wire. SPACE BUNS broke a step slowly leaving the start, rushed up to be forwardly placed in the early stages, tracked the moderate pace while saving ground approaching the turn, loomed at the quarter marker then took command into upper stretch, drew to a clear lead at the furlong marker and was kept to task while a bit green into the final sixteenth, switched leads into deep stretch, felt pressure from oncoming rivals late and held safely in the end for a good debut win. JOYFUL MISCHIEF lacked early speed and was well behind the pace in the early running, was given a shake of the reins after passing the half mile pole and started to improve position racing four wide through the turn, swung six wide into the stretch and rallied boldly down the middle of the track to gain the place. KNOW ABOUT AUTISM broke a beat slow then rushed up to join the early fray, pressed the pace three wide racing between horses through the turn, went into a stiff drive from the five-sixteenths pole, ran on under strong handling and intermittent urging but was passed late for second. HELLO KID O KID O was allowed to settle from the break and tracked mid-pack down the backstretch, got caught in tight approaching the turn and checked at the three-furlong marker, chased three then four wide nearing the quarter pole, swung five wide into upper stretch, lost ground at the furlong marker, re-rallied late and missed for third. CHOKECHERY SHARI outrun early, chased the field three wide through the turn, ran on some through the stretch and offered a mild late response. SOLAR BURST brushed the left side of the gate at the start, then rushed up to join the early leaders then steadled after passing the five furlong pole, losing some forward momentum tracked behind the large group contesting the lead on the turn, then began to struggle to keep up with about three furlongs to run and had nothing to offer in the stretch. KAIA broke well but was hung out five wide for the run down the backstretch, contested the pace three wide through the turn then came up e
