ACCIDENTAL GENIUS close up to the early pace, tracked from the inside into the first turn, saved ground while well placed through the backstretch run, chased from the inside into the second turn, swung outside of rivals at the quarter pole and mounted a three to four wide rally into the lane, closed fast into the final sixteenth and got up in time for the win. MALA allowed to settle in the early going while never far back, saved ground into the first turn then moved out to track the pace while widest into the backstretch, well placed nearing the half-mile marker, mounted a four wide bid into the far turn and vied for the lead into upper stretch, took command at the furlong grounds, dug in and led into the final sixteenth, was tagged by the oncoming winner in deep stretch and held at the wire for second. UNPRETENTIOUS was forwardly placed to begin, tracked the early pace three wide into the first turn, attended to the moderate pace through the backstretch run, bid three then two wide and between rivals nearing the quarter pole, took a narrow lead into upper stretch and battled to the furlong marker, was overtaken past mid-stretch but fought on into the final sixteenth, was outfinished in deep stretch and held clearly for third. ESCAPE PLAN broke alertly and assumed early command, set the pace into the first turn, carved out moderate fractions into the backstretch, came under pressure into the far turn and led to the quarter pole, battled into upper stretch, could not keep pace into the final furlong and gave way late.

CRYPTO CRUSH was crowded at the start by a neighboring rival and was off slowly, settled off of the moderate early pace while not far back, raced three wide into the turn and loomed nearing the quarter marker, responded to urging into upper stretch, rallied and vied for the lead past the furlong marker, took command into the final sixteenth and drew away late. HAKUHIA broke in at the start and bothered CRYPTO CRUSH leaving the gate, settled off of the early pace, improved position two to three wide along the turn, angled out into upper stretch and advanced at the furlong marker, could not impact the winner into the final sixteenth but finished well late and got up for second at the wire. KINKY MOON hopped at the start and was away a bit slowly, rushed up in the early going and stalked the pace heading to the half-mile pole while outside of rivals, pressed the pace two to three wide along the turn, took command into upper stretch and led to the furlong pole, was overtaken by the winner nearing the sixteenth-pole, could not keep pace with the winner into deep stretch and was outfinished late for second. PALACE MISCHIEF away in good order, tracked the moderate early pace from the inside, saved ground into the turn and was well placed nearing the quarter pole, waited for racing room behind a tiring rival approaching the top of the stretch, shifted out at the three-sixteenths, ran evenly to mid-stretch and was outkicked in the final sixteenth. GLORY N THEHIGHEST close up to the early pace, tracked between runners heading to the half-mile marker, well placed into the turn, chased two wide and between rivals along the bend then got caught in tight at the quarter pole, found room into upper stretch, chased to the furlong marker and could not muster the needed late response. LIL BIT THIRSTY broke alertly, showed speed and set the early pace, set the pace a bit off of the rail into the turn, was overtaken past the quarter pole and tired in the stretch drive. SOUTHERN BLESSING tracked the moderate early pace from between rivals, was outrun into the turn, trailed into upper stretch and came up empty in the late stages.

SMILING LADY broke well, dueled with PROOF OF JAZZ through the clubhouse turn, then opened up a clear lead down the backstretch, remained well in front through the far turn then increased the margin in the stretch while being kept to task. PROOF OF JAZZ broke well and pressed SMILING LADY through the first turn, ceded the lead to that one as the field turned into the backstretch, moved out to the three path, came under a ride from the three furlong pole, lost the second position approaching the quarter pole, was kept to task down the stretch and regained second in deep stretch. J AND M EXPRESS tracked well behind the pacesetter for the first half mile, launched a bid from the seven-sixteenths pole, passed PROOF OF JAZZ for the second position near the quarter pole then began to shorten strides near the furlong maker and was passed by that foe. VULIN was allowed to settle from the break and raced between a trio of horses at the rear of the field through the first turn. dropped back to last before the half mile pole and was never a factor. DERRYGOOLIN was being hustled from the gate but was not able to contest the pace, settled inside of three horses racing near the rear of the field through the early stages, was under a ride early on, started to fade near the three furlong marker was outrun the rest of the way.

WRONG DIRECTION settled off of the early pace, saved ground into the first turn and was well placed into the backstretch run, tracked the decent pace from the second flight and between rivals heading to the half-mile marker, navigated traffic into the second turn and was roused four wide at the quarter pole, rallied into the stretch and chased LANGSTON ROAD nearing the furlong marker, reeled in that foe into the final sixteenth, was crowded in deep stretch by the drifting LANGSTON ROAD and got up in the final strides for a determined win. LANGSTON ROAD broke sharply and sped to the early lead, drew clear into the first turn and was well handled while showing the way into the backstretch run, set moderate fractions to the second turn and maintained a clear lead into upper stretch, was set down for the drive and was clear past the furlong marker, confronted by WRONG DIRECTION into the final sixteenth, drifted while all out in deep stretch, was nailed on the wire for the win and was clear of the rest for second. PLAYBOY STYLE was forwardly placed away from the start, settled just off of the early pace and tracked three to four wide along the first turn, well placed into the backstretch run, chased five to six wide into the second turn, ran evenly to mid-stretch, could not impact the top pair late and offered a mild rally in deep stretch to close the gap. GALLANT WARREN allowed to settle in the early going, saved ground into the first turn, was unhurried through the backstretch run and saved all of the ground to the second turn, gained ground and came within range at the quarter pole, chased into upper stretch, could not match strides with the leaders into the final furlong and was outkicked. RULER OF ANGELS off a bit slowly leaving the start, was allowed to settle in the early stages, improved position along the backstretch run, got caught in tight nearing the second turn, found room and advanced two to three wide at the quarter pole, could not sustain his run

into the stretch and flattened out in the late stages. CONTINENTAL UNION hustled away from the start, was forwardly placed to begin and stalked the early pace inside of runners, moved to the outside entering the backstretch run, tracked the loose pacesetter heading to the half-mile marker, chased two to three wide into the second turn, ran in pursuit into the stretch, could not keep pace into the final sixteenth and gave way late. BRONZE WARRIOR settled off of the early pace, raced two to three wide and between runners into the first turn, unhurried through the backstretch, was outrun into the second turn and could not muster a late response. COOPERKLIMT allowed to settle away from the start, was guided three to four wide into the first turn, raced widest through the backstretch run, chased five to six wide into the second turn, maintained a wide path into the stretch and failed to threaten late. ALMANERA (IRE) hard sent leaving the start, was prominent in the early stages and tracked the pace three wide into the first turn, was well placed into the backstretch run, tracked the moderate pace heading to the half-mile marker, chased three to four wide into the far turn, could not keep pace at the quarter pole and tired in the stretch drive.
