TIME TO SING was away in good order and stalked the pacesetter in the opening quarter, let out a notch and steadily advanced along the rail to engage CASH'S PAL for the lead with three furlongs left to run, matched strides while still unasked past the quarter pole, shook free from rival leaving the turn, cut the corner turning for home, tapped right handed, responded willingly, widened to a clear advantage, tapped a couple more times right handed, stayed inside, continued to pull away and was ridden out in the final sixteenth.
