NULLARBOR led the way around the first turn, vied inside of EZ FITZ up the backstretch, shook free around the far turn, saved ground entering the lane, widened advantage under right handed pressure and held late. FORCED RANKING settled through early stages, picked up the pace three to four wide late on the far turn, hustled along into the upper stretch and was getting to the winner late. EZ FITZ was forwardly placed around the first turn, vied outside of eventual winner winner up the backstretch, could not match strides around the far turn and weakened to show. OPTIMAL TRIP raced off the pace, chased three wide around the final turn, ran on into the lane but lacked the needed response for late impact. HUSKER BUTCH tracked the early pace, failed to advance under pressure around the far turn and faded in the lane. STREET GLIDE raced off the pace, was ridden along two wide into the upper stretch and had no response. ASSET BASIS stalked the pace up the backstretch, weakened around the far turn and continued to tire in the drive.
