SHAME ON STEVE was forwardly placed up the backstretch, hustled along three wide late on the turn, drifted four wide entering the head of the lane, sustained a steady bid down the lane and got a nose up on the wire. BRASA sprinted out for the early lead then came under pressure late on the backstretch, took on the rail bid from RED KINGDOM mid-way around the turn, dueled outside of rival into the lane, dug in gamely under firm handling and got nipped when SHAME ON STEVE put a nose in front on the wire. RED KINGDOM pressed the early pace then advanced along the rail to challenge BRASA mid-way around the turn, battled back gamely from the inside down the lane and got edged late. WILY WADE was ridden along off the early pace and saved ground, angled two to three wide for the drive and improved position without threatening the top trio. DUSAN raced in range up the backstretch, continued four wide in contention late on the turn, got carried out wider by eventual winner entering the head of the lane, hustled along for more but had no late kick. BARN BUSTER dropped to last after the opening quarter and had no late response.
