SKIP THE LINE vied inside around the turn, continued to battle with WHITING FIELD up the backstretch, shook free entering the far turn, pulled away under steady encouragement and kept to task. J T'S IMAGINATION was unhurried and raced off the early pace, saved ground around the far turn, hustled along the rail into the stretch and finished second best. ICE AGAIN was forwardly placed around the first turn, tracked the top pair up the backstretch, came under right handed pressure three wide at the head of the lane, sustained a steady bid and secured show. DINNER AT CRUMPIES sat off the clear top trio up the backstretch, was ridden along three to four wide into the lane and lacked the needed response for serious impact. WHITING FIELD slightly bobbed at the start then advanced to duel for the lead around the first turn, continued to battle with the SKIP THE LINE up the backstretch, could not move on with the eventual winner entering the far turn and steadily weakened. BOUGIE JOE raced in the back through early stages, saved ground, shifted out three to four wide at the head of the lane, hustled along for response but failed to move on. EZ FITZ raced off the pace, swung wide into the lane and failed to threaten.
