KEITHSENDSHELLOOOO settled off the pace, advanced inside, then between rivals on the far turn, rallied four wide into the stretch, dug in gamely outside in the final furlong, dueled and prevailed in the final yards. SAL N LOUIE raced off the rail, off the pace, moved up four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the lane, closed well outside and surged in deep stretch. WE READY raced four wide early, settled three wide off the pace, made a four wide run on the far turn, took over, drew clear, then dug in gamely and dueled to the finish. UNION LIGHTS raced off the rail, off the pace, moved up three wide on the far turn, angled in and closed belatedly on the rail. MOSE PERFECT vied two wide, dueled on the far turn and weakened. RERALLY raced three wide early, stalked two wide, chased on the far turn, bid three wide at the quarter pole and weakened. DEPLANE off a step slow, raced off the pace with an inside trip,

came two wide into the lane and had no rally. UNINVITED GUEST tracked on the inside, chased and gave way. BATTER UP BUD was a bit reluctant to load, then dwelt at the start and was outrun. MEGA CHARLIE vied inside for the lead, dueled on the far turn and gave way. After a Stewards' Inquiry into the start, the race was declared official.
