FROM THE TOP ROPE broke best, went to the front while drifting out clear of the other starters, ceded the lead to MO TA after a furlong, moved up to retake the front approaching the quarter pole with no resistance from that rival, opened up in the stretch, and held clear to the wire under steady handling in a solid debut. MOMACYA tracked three wide through the early stages, chased FROM THE TOP ROPE down the stretch while racing a bit greenly but was clear of the next finisher. GIFT OF GRACE raced mid-pack along the rail, well off the pace, tipped out three-wide into the stretch and finished with some interest under steady handling and urging to gain the minor award. OH JULIET balked at the load, then did not get away well at the break, kept to the inside paths through the turn, and finished with good energy while never a serious threat. SIVAKO was not asked for speed from the start, advanced from last down the backstretch, then bid in earnest leaving the three-furlong pole, ran on well through the stretch, could not get to the winner but finished well clear of the next horse. ZIA ZAPPER was allowed to settle into stride from the break, was unhurried at the back of the pack through the early stages, commenced a steady, long drive on the turn, and finished with a late gain to be up for the show. MO SATURDAYS dueled to the outside of CAMPFIRE CREED to the far turn, put a head in front passing the five-sixteenths marker, was unable to kick on with the eventual winner, and went one-paced to the finish. I AM GRODD raced three wide in the middle of the pack, then lacked a rally. WORTH LOOKING was pushed forward from the break, then settled along the rail in a tracking position a couple of lengths behind the leading group, came under a ride heading into the far turn, but did not respond and had little to offer in the stretch. CAMPFIRE CREED dueled through moderate fractions, gave way approaching the quarter pole, and was not a factor in the stretch run. XYNGIN SPITFIRE showed good speed from the break, took command at the seven-sixteenths marker, opened up through the turn under confident handling, responded when roused in upper stretch, but gave way in the final furlong. SMART OKIE broke well but dropped far behind before the turn and made a mild late bid to pass one near the finish. RASPBERRY MARTINI broke on top then dueled with XYNGIN SPITFIRE into the turn, could not keep pace late on the turn, and weakened in the late stages. COLONEL YORKE settled mid-pack while saving ground throughout, squeezed through a tight spot just before the chute and surged clear in the final yards. GO GO BOSS took a light bump just after the start, got over to the two-path going into the first turn, tracked mid-pack a few lengths off the pace, bided time in cover down the backstretch, was able to get free in mid-stretch, and surged late but came up short to the winner. GOLD FRONT sent to the front from the break, pressed the moderate pace to the outside of TEXAS CREED to the far turn, let that rival get first run into the stretch, came back to overtake that rival late, but got outkicked by the top pair in the last jumps. TEXAS CREED broke well, led the way into the stretch under mild pressure, kicked on well turning for home with a clear lead, battled gamely to deep stretch, but came up short in the end in a solid effort. DOWN THE ISLANDS settled three-wide in mid-pack early, advanced closer down the backstretch, loomed three-wide at the top of the stretch, finished up well, but could not find the winning kick. DARK AFTERNOON reserved off the early pace, checked twice down the backstretch to avoid clipping heels, produced a bold rally in the stretch to get up in plenty of time despite drifting in and out in mid-stretch. JACKMAN'S RIDE was quickest away from the gate, seized the front, opened up in the stretch, but could not hold off the winner in the final yards. PRINCE LANCELOT (GB) raced wel behind the rest through the early stages, saved ground throughout, then rallied late to claim third. ORDER OF MERIT chased JACKMAN'S RIDE from the start, made a run at that rival on the turn, proved no match and weakened in the stretch. TWENTYONE N CHANGE raced well off the pace early, then was unable to keep up or threaten late.

WAVER kept close to PONDICHERRY while traveling well, moved up leaving the three-furlong pole to challenge for the lead, took command at the three-sixteenths pole, and drew away in the stretch under a hand ride. BEACHYA bumped at the start, then was allowed to settle near the rear, then advanced through the turn three or four wide, loomed a big threat in upper stretch but could not match the winner late and had to settle for second best. FIND THE LIGHT ducked out into BEACHYA at the start, then raced in the middle of the pack, never far from the front, started a mild bid on the turn, and was steadily gaining some in the late stages to gain third while never a serious threat to the winner. PASSANDO settled in the middle of the pack, three-wide down the backstretch, was not making much progress through the turn, had some trouble with the lead change in upper stretch then found a good stride in deep stretch and just missed out on a minor award. PONDICHERRY veered out at the start but still made the front and went clear early, maintained the margin through the turn, then gave way to WAVER in upper stretch and tired. DARETOCATCHLOVE was not involved early, raced four wide well off the pace, made a mild middle move on the turn, then drifted about six or seven wide and finished evenly. BOUGIE LIKE raced four or five wide with the second flight, made a four-wide bid late on the turn but faltered before the stretch and had little to offer late. OUR GIRL FLINT lacked any early pace, dropped over to the rail before the turn, but was unable to make any impact in the stretch. WISHFUL WINKER was in a drive from the start, pressed the pace into the turn, then steadily retreated and had nothing left for the stretch run. KNOTTY KITTY raced close up inside to the turn, then struggled to keep pace, dropped far back, was eased in mid-stretch, galloped out to the wire and walked off.
