LET'S GO MARK stalked the pace from between horses down the backside, closed the gap on the bend while under patient handling waiting for a hole to present itself, tipped three wide to the clear at the top of the lane and closed well wearing the stubborn pacesetter down late. LET HIM BE set a pressured pace through the turn, briefly kicked away in upper stretch, responded gamely through the lane and gave way to the winner grudgingly. BIG CHOPPER unhurried to be the trailer in a compact field, rallied circled the field turning for home and closed well to be gaining late. SENOR ROJO was reserved off the leaders racing five wide to be in striking distance at the top of the lane and put in a mild bid in the stretch without impact gaining a minor award. LAST ATTACK hustled to press the pace through the turn and weakened in the stretch. FLYING CAESAR was well placed racing along the inside to the turn and dropped back on the bend unable to keep pace and chased on willingly down the lane.

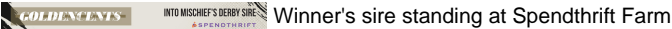

TO TOO TWENTYTWO reserved in mid-pack through the turn, rallied under a long drive in the lane to engage the leader inside the eighth pole and was going away in deep stretch under confident handling. CAJUN WARRIOR unhurried in the early going to be near the rear of the field, rallied five wide on the turn to take the lead turning for home, kicked away in upper stretch and weakened late unable to hold off the closing winner. CHASING THE RUSH stalked th pace down the backside, rallied on the bend from between rivals to challenge for the lead, flattened out in upper stretch unable to sustain the bid and drifted wide while finishing evenly. HASHTAGMAKITHAPPEN pressed th pace for the first quarter, dropped back through the field on the turn lacking a response and ran-on evenly to recalim a spot on the board. WAVE AFTER WAVE was not a threat. PASA DOBLE set a pressured pace to nearly the quarter pole and tired at the head of the stretch.

CRYSTAL CLAIRE avoided stumbling rival leaving the gate, tracked down the backside, rallied to the lead nearing the quarter pole, drew away in upper stretch and was unthreatened down the lane. CALLITFATELUCKARMA steadied in the first eighth when in tight between rivals, regained stride to track the leaders and rallied well in the lane to gain the place. GETTIN OUT OF HERE prompted the pace to the turn, rallied to threaten near the quarter pole, was no match for the winner and ran-on through the lane willingly. WEST TEXAS RUBY well palced just off the pace along the fence on the backstretch and lacked a response when called upon on the turn fading from contention. DA LAST TEQUILA flashed early speed to be the leader, settled off the pace down the backside and was outrun. FIRST WORDS stumbled badly unseating the rider at the break and walked off.

TRAFALGAR SHORE set the pace under steady pressure from the runner-up, dueled with that one to the late stretch, fianlly turned that one away to draw clear in hte final fifty yards. CAJUN NINJA pressed the pace to midway on the turn, fully engaged the winner nearing the quarter pole, battled through the lane and could not get passed while proving to be second best in a game effort. BLUEBONNET GIRL stalked the leaders from the three path down the backside, responded when called upon turning for home, could not keep pace with the top pair and kept-on willingly to hold the show. ICY RIVER unhurried in the early going, circled five wide on the turn to range up into contention and mounted a mild bid in the lane. YVONNE'S MISS raced near the back most of the way and showed some late interest. MAMASHAVNAHOTFLASH pinched back at the start to be the earlytrailer and never posed a threat. CHARMONTE raced up the inside to be in contention down the backside, was called upon early on the bend and offered no response.

BROTHER REID reserved off the pace for the first half mile, closed the gap through the turn, angled six wide turning for home and closed with a late surge to prevail in thr final yards. GOOD SWIMMER tracked the leaders from four wide through the far turn, rallied coming for home to engage the leaders in mid-stretch, took the lead late in the lane and was caught by the fast finishing winner in a good effort. COASTAL BRINK was well placed just off the leader to the far turn, remained in striking distance prominently placed turning for home, rallied to draw even with the leaders in mid-stretch and was outkicked late. TEAM LEADER prompted the pace to the final bend, moved to engage the pacesetter nearing the quarter pole, took the lead in mid-stretch and was outfinished deep in the drive. MACKINNON was slow early to be at the rear of the pack, remained well off the leaders turning for home and mounted a belated bid in the lane. LOGICAL MYTH was reserved along the inside onto the backstretch, raced up narrowing the gap from between rivals down the backside, remained in tighth quarters through the turn steadyng near the quarter pole and ran-on evenly through the lane. VALID EURO slow early to be the trailer, rallied turning for home splitting rivals and closed with a belated rush to be gaining late. BIG KITTY pressed the pace to the turn, lost position on the bend and ran-on in the lane. WAYLON'S GUITAR was reserved off the pace and mounted a mild bid in the stretch. LUCKY TAPITURE failed to menace. CHI TOWN ROAD stalked the pace from five wide in the turn after having been part of the early pace duwl and weakened coming home. OUT TO PARTY was not a threat. DEVIOUS DENNIS raced mid-pack early, spurted up the rail into the turn to press and flattened out in the lane. YOGOTTHISJR was not a factor. DA CHIEF hustled up the outside to be part of the five way pace duel and gave way on the turn.
