LET'S GO MARK stalked the pace from between horses down the backside, closed the gap on the bend while under patient handling waiting for a hole to present itself, tipped three wide to the clear at the top of the lane and closed well wearing the stubborn pacestter down late. LET HIM BE set a pressured pace through the turn, briefly kicked away in upper stretch, responded gamely through the lane and gave way to the winner grudgingly. BIG CHOPPER unhurried to be the trailer in a compact field, rallied circled the field turning for home and closed well to be gaining late. SENOR ROJO was reserved off the leaders racing five wide to be in striking distance at the top of the lane and put in a mild bid in the stretch without impact gaining a minor award. LAST ATTACK hustled to press the pace through the turn and weakened in the stretch. FLYING CAESAR was well placed racing along the inside to the turn and dropped back on the bend unable to keep pace and chased on willingly down the lane.
