MAGNA TAP settled between horses near the back, made a forward move late on the backstretch, then set down a challenge to I'M ENTICING on the lead near the three-furlong pole, put a head in front near the quarter pole, and finished best to win clear. WORK ZONE broke well, settled mid-pack two wide, moved up late on the backstretch, waited for room between horses on the far turn, tipped out three-wide at the top of the stretch, finished well but could not get to the winner. UPTONO BUENA tracked inside off the pace, then moved up to be close up with the leading group heading into the second turn, was stuck behind the tiring REDFORK midway through the turn, got clear in the stretch, and finished up well. I'M ENTICING showed good speed from the break but ceded the lead and backed off to a stalking position, took over the front-running duties approaching the half-mile pole, responded to a challenge from MAGNA TAP with three furlongs to run, cut the corner, and fought on gamely, then weakened in deep stretch. DRAMA CODE tucked into the two-path after a decent start, tracked in mid-pack down the backstretch, moved up to bid for the lead approaching the three-furlong pole, but was unable to go with MAGNA TAP, lugged in, and was not a factor in the later stages. WAR FOR GOLD went three-wide through the clubhouse turn, then tracked five-wide down the backstretch, made a sweeping three-wide move through the far turn, came five-wide into the stretch but could not carry the momentum and was outfinished. AMARONA SIOUX stalked just behind COMPETITIVE BOND from the start, made a bid leaving the quarter pole but was unable to close the gap and chased that rival to the wire while finishing well clear of the next horse. CRYPTIC MISS broke with the pack but could not keep up early, launched a bid from the three-furlong pole, dropped down to the rail, and finished up well under urging to gain the minor award. COWBOYCENTS mutually bumped with BIG COUNTRY BOY at the start, leading to a slow break, then rushed up to join the early pace fray to make it a quartet, kept the inside position through the turn, emerged into the stretch with a slight lead, put STONINGTON away by mid-stretch, and held sway over a fast closing late rival. BISHOP CREEK was the distant trailer to the turn, then came five-wide turning for home and produced a bold late rally to pass all but the winner in the stretch. STONINGTON veered out at the start, then raced three-wide with the tracking group, launched a bid with three furlongs to run, finished up well under steady handling and urging, and just got up for the show dough. HANK HILL raced three-wide in the early pace battle, was one of two left to fight to the finish in the stretch, fought on gamely but was outfinished in the final yards. RICKIE ROOOO STER tracked well behind the pace battle in the second flight, came four wide into the stretch but could not produce the needed response. TRESILLIAN was four wide in the early pace battle, fanned four wide into the stretch, and flatted out near the furlong marker. TRUE RICARDO broke slow, chased behind the speed duel under a drive, struggled to keep up through the turn, and was not involved late. ECHOS OF VIOLENCE broke inward at the start but was one of the first away, vied inside of a pair of rivals and the three pulled well clear of the rest through the turn, took command leaving the quarter pole, got a late challenge from a resurgent TIZ A TEN I SEE, drifted out in the final yards making some conact with that rival but held on. TIZ A TEN I SEE ducked out at the start, bothering LOQUACIOUS LOUAN, was still away well and vied between horses to the stretch, dropped back a bit near the five-sixteenths marker, but came back on in the stretch, gradually closed the gap on ECHOES OF VIOLENCE in the final yards, and took a light bump near the line. GIVEITASPIN broke a step slow, then got shuffled back, steadily advanced from that slow start to be within range of the leading trio at the top of the stretch, finished well, but was not getting to the top pair in the late stages. MOTHER OF PEARL was the outside horse in the early pace scramble, fanned three wide at the top of the stretch, then weakened. AUNT PENNY raced inside from the middle of the pack, then was unable to threaten. SCATTERED MISCHIEF tracked three-wide and lacked a rally. GIRLS KNICKS NOW broke well, was briefly close up with the pace battle, dropped back late on the backstretch, lost ground through the turn, and faltered in the stretch. SHE'S A COWGIRL ducked in, in then steadied to correct, raced inside the trio at the back, broke away from the other two in the stretch, but could not improve beyond that. JAUNTY shied from a rival at the start, raced with the trailing trio, outfinished LOQUÁCIOUS LOUAN to avoid finishing in last place. LOQUACIÓUS LOUAN was always outrun and never a factor. THE RIDER ON #7 TIZ A TEN I SEE LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST #6 ECHOES OF VIOLENCE ALLEGING INTERFERENCE NEAR THE FINISH LINE. AFTER A LENGTHY REVIEW THE OBJECTION WAS DISALLOWED AND THE ORIGINAL ORDER OF FINISH WAS MADE OFFICIAL.

#### Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

IMUA KAI broke well and established a forward position before the first turn, raced mid-pack and seemingly comfortable with the pace situation, launched a bid midway through the far turn, finished well under strong handling and intermittent urging and got up in the last jumps. ONE TIME MARK hustled from the break and settled in a stalking position behind SUMMER HELP, ceded the front expecting that rival to come back to the field, went into a drive approaching the quarter pole, had a little trouble with the lead change in upper stretch, but surged once straightened out and just missed. SUMMER HELP sprinted to a clear early lead, opened up turning into the stretch, was desperate for the wire inside the sixteenth, and was overtaken near the finish line. SPONGE BATH not asked for speed from the break, tracked in mid-pack on the rail, moved up down the backstretch to get within striking distance of the leader, finished up well, but found best stride too late. AIN'T THAT A KICK raced at the front of the trailing group, made a four-wide bid through the last turn and into the stretch then flattened out. BIG COMMERCE went three-wide through the first turn, settled three-wide at the back, moved up on the far turn, but could not generate a late kick. OKIE CLIPPER held up at the back through the early running, saved ground and finished evenly. SINGING DIXIE missed the break, settled at the back of the field, and lacked a rally. KANTAKE was slow into stride, dropped far behind early and never threatened.
