COMPETITIVE BOND moved up after a tardy start to take command near the five-furlong pole under mild restraint, was confidently ridden through the turn, responded when set down in upper stretch, and held clear under steady handling. AMARONA SIOUX stalked just behind COMPETITIVE BOND from the start, made a bid leaving the quarter pole but was unable to close the gap and chased that rival to the wire while finishing well clear of the next horse. CRYPTIC MISS broke with the pack but could not keep up early, launched a bid from the three-furlong pole, dropped down to the rail, and finished up well under urging to gain the minor award. SHE'S A READER broke well, chased the top pair, finished with some interest miles clear of the next horse but was never a serious threat. GOSPEL B. HAVIOR was slow to get going from the start, saved ground throughout but was never a factor. FRECKLES FOREVER broke well, chased close up to the turn, started to retreat from the three-furlong pole, was eased up to the wire, and reported to have bled. GOSPEL TREASURE dropped far back early and trailed throughout.
