CASH FOLLOWS ME showed good speed from the break, vied between horses to the turn, then dueled with IN BOND WE TRUST for the last three furlongs, responded when roused mid-stretch, opened up, and won well. IN BOND WE TRUST vied then dueled to the outside of CASH FOLLOWS ME, was even up with that one to mid-stretch, then had no answer when that foe quickened away, but held second clear of the next horse. WINDTAPPER WIN settled behind the trio contesting the early pace, chased the top pair the rest of the way, finishing a mile clear of the next horse. ACE OF CLUBS was off poorly, spotting the rest a huge head start, rallied late to pass TEXAS FARMER but otherwise could not make up the lost ground. TEXAN FARMER was up with the pace to the turn, then faded.
