AFTERNOON DIVA sprinted clear from the break, was joined after a furlong by a pair of rivals pressing the issue to the outside, was always traveling well, edged clear midway through the turn, opened up in the stretch and held on despite a mildly diminishing margin. STRIKETHREEYOUROUT rushed up to contest the early pace between rivals, backed off a bit on the turn, came under pressure in upper stretch, kept on well and just managed to hold second. LA MORENA was under some coaxing from the break but unable to join the early pace battle, raced with another rival off the pace, swung four wide into the stretch and rallied willingly, but came up short and had to settle for the minor award. CRYSTAL CLAIRE was outpaced initially but found a good stride near the half-mile pole, tracked along the rail inside LA MORENA, loomed a mild threat in the stretch but was outfinished. SHE'S A BOND TOO broke well, moved up to press the pace three wide down the backstretch, was unable to go with AFTERNOON DIVA when that rival quickened but remained within striking distance turning for home, then flattened out at midstretch and finished evenly. MUCHO MIA was devoid of early speed and trailed well behind the field, kept to the two path, was unable to generate a meaningful late bid but regained contact with the field through the late stages.

STRAIGHTAWAY broke alertly and won the scramble to the first turn, ceded the lead to a rival entering the backstretch while remaining in a stalking position along the inside, responded readily when asked past the half-mile pole, raced on even terms through the far turn, then quickened clear at the top of the stretch and drew away from the rest. FOUR JIM was held up in midpack along the inside under a tight hold, was stuck behind rivals late on the far turn, found room along the rail turning into the stretch, could not threaten the winner but outfinished the rest to gain the place. HEATS HERO broke outward, settled in the middle of the field, lacked a clear path through the far turn, came out four wide for the stretch run and rallied mildly to gain the third prize. CODE MANDALORE displayed good speed from the start and took a slight lead coming out of the first turn, stayed on even terms with the inside rival to the stretch, was unable to match that one's acceleration, but stayed on willingly to the finish. BOUNDLESS OPTIMIST was bothered by an inside rival and shuffled back after the break, settled at the rear, saved ground throughout and improved mildly through the stretch, but was never a serious threat. WHISKEY SHOT was caught four wide on the first turn, moved up into a stalking position behind the leaders down the backstretch, launched a bid approaching the three-furlong pole, came three wide into the stretch under urging but failed to produce the needed response. UPTONO BUENA was three-wide throughout and lacked a finish. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

TIPOFF was quickest from the start and made the early lead, opened a clear advantage late on the turn, and continued to widen through the stretch. R R JOKER tracked inside while off the pace, was full of run but without a clear path through the turn, found an opening at the head of the stretch and finished strongly despite having trouble changing leads, then prevailed in the battle for second without threatening the winner. OH WELL IT'S WEMBY was outpaced through the first quarter mile and angled to the inside when clear, dropped back to last on the turn, then rallied sharply through the stretch and got up for third. ECHO BAY tracked in midpack outside R R JOKER and continued evenly through the late stages. YOURGOINGTOJAIL stalked the two leaders three wide through the early stages, was unable to go with TIPOFF when that rival quickened near the quarter pole and failed to threaten thereafter. MR. CANDY MAN pressed TIPOFF from the outside down the backstretch, came under pressure near the quarter pole and faltered through the stretch. MAXIMUS FLATTER veered out sharply at the start, had only one rival beaten approaching the half-mile pole, remained three to four wide through the turn and failed to produce a late bid.

ORE MINE broke well and pressed the early pace from the inside, came under a ride when the leader began to slip away late on the turn, came back on in upper stretch and finished a clear second. BERRY MISCHIEVOUS hustled from the break to take a narrow early lead with two rivals in close attendance, opened up a bit approaching the quarter pole, carried the lead into the stretch but was outfinished while holding third.
