YODA WINNER brushed with the horse to her inside at the start, moved up to press the pace racing up the backstretch, drifted out to the three path coming around the turn, swung wider still into the stretch and held clear to the wire. CLOUD ANGEL tracked the leaders on the outside early, swung out to the five path to began a bid approaching the quarter pole and gained ground steadily to the finish. CUR NON brushed with the horse to her outside leaving the gate, recovered to lead the way from the rail up the backstretch, saved ground around the bend and could not go with the winner in the lane but chased on from there. LA CAMELIA trailed the field up the backstretch, navigated the turn from the four path, began a bid entering the stretch and gained ground late. CHECKER'S SONG raced off the pace between horses through the opening quarter, began a bid from the four path coming around the far turn and finished evenly. CRAFTY AUNT raced in the middle of the pack between horses up the backstretch, continued around the turn in the two path and showed no kick. VERY UNLIKELY raced off the pace on the outside up the backstretch, navigated the bend from the three path and was outkicked in the lane. MYA WAY raced at the back of the pack through the opening stages, came around the turn in the two path and made no bid. MOON CRATER chased the leader on the inside up the backstretch, saved ground around the turn and faded in the stretch. AUTISM RESILIENCE stalked the leaders between horses up the backstretch, dropped back while racing in the two path around the turn and continued to tire from there.

WAYLON'S GUITAR settled in the middle of the pack on the outside for the run up the backstretch, began a bid from the four path coming around the turn, dueled in the lane and narrowly missed the place. OUT TO PARTY raced off the pace on the outside through the opening stages, swung out to the five path coming around the bend and passed tiring horse from there. DA CHIEF bumped with the horse to his outside at the start, recovered to lead the way on the inside up the backstretch, came around the turn in the two path and tired in the lane. SEVEN DEVILS ROAD raced off the pace on the inside early, navigated the turn from the four path and made no bid.
