LARIDAE raced off the pace from four wide to the turn then tipped in to save ground to the top of the stretch then moved back out to four wide to make a rally but was not enough. MR PELOTON raced near the back from five wide to the turn then tipped in to two wide mild bid around the turn then move back out to five wide in upper stretch to make the late run and improved position. HAY SCOOBY DOO pressed the pace from two wide to the top of the stretch but lacked the late response and weakened. HE'S A ROCK raced close up from five wide to the turn then tipped in to three wide around the turn but lacked the late kick and faded. PROMISE CODE was void of speed and was outrun.
