HAPPY N SMILING chased the early pace while three wide into the turn, rallied four wide in the stretch and was in a strong drive to the wire. BUSINESS AS USUAL was saving ground on the turn then rallied two wide in the stretch, was gaining ground and was second best in the end. PONDICHERRY set a pressured pace while two wide, drew off on the turn then was in a long drive but weakened in late stretch. AN AWESOME LEGACY pressed the early pace while three wide on the turn, made a bid in the stretch but faltered in late stretch. SAY AS I SAY was unhurried early then made a mild rally in the stretch but failed to menace. PRAIRIE BRAT broke in the air at the start then was hustled along into the turn, raced five wide in the stretch and closed willingly in the end. UNBRIDLED KISSES was saving ground on the turn then made a three wide bid in the stretch but was no threat. FOOLISH AFFAIR rallied three wide on the turn but was no threat in the stretch. PRESLEYS VOLLEY showed good early speed inside into the turn then was used up and gave way. ROCKITRETTA was inside on the turn and no threat. TOTAL INSANITY raced five wide on the turn and was no factor. WEST TEXAS RUBY bore out on

the turn to be seven wide and no threat.
