HOWBOUTCHA took a bump from THE BIRDMAN but otherwise came away well, vied three deep in the early pace mix, dueled outside of DOWN PERISCOPE from the three-furlong pole, gained the upper hand by mid-stretch, and held safe from a late bid by RUGGED SAWYER LEE in the final yards. RUGGED SAWYER LEE hustled from the break and was the inside horse in the early pace battle, backed off heading into the turn, but kept to a stalking position on the inside, tipped out to the three path for the stretch run, finished up well despite racing on the wrong lead, closed the gap in the late stages but could not reel in the winner. PONTOTOC was not involved in the early pace, settled three-wide in the second flight, then advanced on the leaders on the turn, finished well under steady handling to move into third, but was not getting to the top two. THE BIRDMAN veered out at the start into HOWBOUTCHA, then overcorrected and brushed with SASSYS CODE TALKER, was under a ride from the start, and lacked a meaningful rally. NJUSTLIKETHAT was forced out a bit by the inside rival after the break, pressed the early pace four-wide, dropped off after passing the half, and was unable to threaten in the later stages. EURO K steadied in traffic in the initial stages, dropped back to last, and was never a factor. CAJUN NINJA pressed the pace three-wide to the stretch, then chased ICY RIVER into the stretch, kept on well under steady handling, and wore down that rival in the shadow of the wire. ICY RIVER vied/dueled for the lead from the rail, gained sole command by upper stretch, dueled with CAJUN NINJA through the stretch, and gave way grudingly in the final yards. SAINT SARENA settled at the back early, launched a bid from the three-furlong pole and rallied into third well behind the top pair. ACCELERATE JUDY broke slowly and a bit awkwardly, chased from last early, made a middle move on the turn but flattened out. KISS AND TELL pressed the pace from between horses, then faltered in the stretch. SAN MATEO KAT chased the trio on the front end from well behind, then tired in the stretch. AWESOME RUTA raced up close along the inside just behind ORE MINE on the lead, alternated leads with that one to the stretch while pulling well clear of the rest, took a clear advantage into the stretch and opened up on the field under steady handling to win clear in the end. JUSTICE DEPARTMENT veered out at the start, settled four-wide in the back half of the field early, started a sustained bid from the seven-sixteenths marker, circled the field to gain contention by the top of the stretch, closed the gap on the leader late but ran out of time. MINTASTIC settled well off the pace early, then kept to task late to gain the third spot. ORE MINE took a slight hop at the break, but still made the lead, dueled outside of that rival to the stretch while taking turns on the front end, then weakened in upper stretch. MAGIC GRANT was outrun early and dropped far behind, ran on some late and managed to split the field. DEVIL'S MISCHIEF was close up three-deep in the run down the backstretch, then chased the leading pair as they forged ahead of the rest of the field, but flattened out in mid-stretch and outfinished through the late stages. WISH MAN raced four-wide near the back, and lacked a finish. FORTHELONGHAUL raced four-wide in the tracking group down the backstretch, then steadily retreated through the turn and had nothing to offer in the late stages. IZE A BLAST lacked early speed and raced at the rear through the early running, advanced up the inside on the turn, but was without a path midway, angled out to the three path before the quarter pole, then finished up well under strong handling to get up in the last jump. STUBBY was a bit keen in the early going with the rider trying to temper the pace, became boxed in early on the turn, seemingly full of run, made a bid up the rail through a narrow opening just past the eight pole, surged to the lead, but lost the bob at the wire. PONDICHERRY broke well, then pulled to take the lead at the half-mile pole, went a length clear through the turn, had a narrow lead turning for home, fought gamely under threat from all sides but was outfinished. BUSINESS AS USUAL was mid-pack four-wide going into the turn, bid for the lead near the three-furlong pole, dueled with PONDICHERRY through the stretch but hung a bit late and missed. CHECKER'S SONG was last to break, settled between horses at the rear of the field, started to run on midway on the turn, and was mildly gaining in the late stages. BELLE BLAZE pressed the early pace three-wide, loomed approaching the stretch, but flattened out. AN AWESOME LEGACY was a bit rank early, then did not respond when asked to go on. DARETOCATCHLOVE raced three-wide and lacked a rally. LIGHT A SHUCK got away well and crossed over towards the inside to take the early lead, ceded the front to PONDICHERRY near the seven-sixteenths marker, then faded to

last on the turn.
