ALL AFLUTTER broke sharply and went to the front, held sway in front of a very compact field through the turn, dug in under threat in upper stretch battled gamely through the stretch, then got the benefit of a favorable head bob at the wire to win the photo. OKIE LOVE broke well but settled off the early pace, bided time through the turn, then was set down from the guarter pole, rallied up the rail and just missed. TOUGH TROOPER broke well, vied three-wide initially, then easily took command passing the three-furlong pole, opened up turning for home, and drew off under steady handling and intermittent urging, drifting out a bit in the final furlong. RUN PISTOL MAGIC steadied early, then took up a few strides later when BIG KITTY took the path, chased the main pack through the turn, bid four-wide into the stretch, and outfinished the rest to gain the place. BIG KITTY stumbled, then broke awkwardly to the outside, causing some trouble for RUN PISTOL MAGIC, steadied, then was put in tight quarters by TOUGH TROOPER, checked away from that one to impede RUN PISTOL MAGIC once again, tracked three-wide down the backstretch, advanced steadily through the turn, was not getting to the winner, but kept to task late to win the battle for the minor award. DOUBLE RAP was hustled from the start, put a head in front early, then dueled with TOUGH TROOPER going into the turn, could not go on with that one in the stretch, then weakened in the final furlong. SOCIAL SOONER put RUN PISTOL MAGIC in a tight spot in the early stages, then was the distant trailer to the turn, then tried to rally five-wide into the stretch, came under a ride before the three-furlong pole, and did not have much of a response in the late stages. BOBCAT BITE settled between horses in the tracking group, came under a stiff ride leaving the three-furlong pole, but had little to offer in the stretch run.

SOUND OF VICTORY tracked the pacesetter close up on the inside, bided time through the far turn while waiting for running room, took the inside path into the stretch, and finished up strong under steady handling and urging to get the nod over a determined rival on the outside. PARKWAY settled three deep with the trio at the back through the first half, ranged up to contest the lead leaving the three-furlong pole, responded when set down at the top of the stretch, and closed willingly but came up short in the end. RIVETAGE lost the path and steadied after the start, went three wide through the far turn, then rallied five-wide in the stretch to move up and grab the minor award. CHARMING TIGER tracked two-wide through the early stages, made a bid for the lead leaving the three-furlong pole, took a slight lead into the stretch, but was outfinished in the final yards. PASS LINE settled near the back of the compact field but not too far from the front, was blocked late on the far turn and into the stretch but did not rally when clear. ZED made the lead without much effort, then opened up by two down the backstretch, led the way into the far turn, then yielded when confronted near the quarter pole and had nothing left for the stretch.
