VENGANZA saved ground off the pace, angled out at the quarter pole, rallied to the front midstretch, drew clear with sixteenth remaining and held safely. SAFA was off a bit slow to begin, raced two wide off the pace into the turn, got floated out past the quarter pole, finished well down the lane to gain second but could not reach the winner. VIBEZ fractious in the gate, tracked two wide into the turn, crossed onto the dirt a bit awkwardly but was not cost any momentum while moving to the three path, bid between rivals with a furlong remaining but got outkicked in the late stages. CONTROL FUNCTION lacked early speed and trailed in the early stages, traveled on the inside then two wide around the bend, summoned a mild rally down the lane and missed third. VITALERA (CHI) stalked the lone leader outside a rival to the turn, challenged from outside at the quarter pole, took over at the top of the lane, relinquished the lead midstretch and weakened in the last sixteenth. SEE THROUGH IT settled off the pace, moved inside for the turn, eased out to the three path around the bend, rallied under right then left handed urging, drew alongside ELWOOD BLUES in deep stretch and got up at the wire. ELWOOD BLUES stalked the speed outside BARTHOLDY early, bid three deep late on the turn, took over in upper stretch, cleared briefly midstretch, challenged by SEE THROUGH IT late and got nailed on the line. BARTHOLDY was closest in pursuit up the backstretch and turn, bid two wide late on the bend, fought between foes entering the lane, fought inside ELWOOD BLUES to the sixteenth pole and could not match the top pair late. MISSION BEACH trailed on the inside into the turn, quickly switched to the two path, moved back inside with a quarter mile remaining, kept trying down the lane but needed to find more. SLIDER showed the way early from inside, confronted by a pair of rivals late on the bend, yielded in upper stretch and weakened in the furlong grounds. CHECK'S ON THE WAY got bumped from inside leaving the gate, chased from off the pace then moved into range up the backstretch, traveled two wide around the bend, moved out in the lane, drew alongside TARGARYIS outside the sixteenth pole and wore down the runner-up. TARGARYIS was closest in pursuit in the early going, bid two wide at the three-eighths pole, gained control then cleared inner rival at the quarter pole, drifted out in the lane while being confronted by CHECK'S ON THE WAY and could not fend off that rival in deep stretch. IT'S A FACTOR bumped outer rival leaving the gate, traveled in mid-pack up the backstretch, rounded the bend in the two path, steered out widest in the lane and came with a mild rally to earn the show. A VOTRE SANTE tracked from inside, saved ground through the turn, moved off the fence in the drive and finished evenly late. VALENTINES CANDY saved ground from off the pace, lacked room behind rivals and checked with a furlong remaining, altered out to a clear path and kept trying while failing to threaten. ESCAPE PLAN broke a step slow then lost a clear path early, trailed along the inside, angled out off the fence and failed to menace.
