DEALERS SPECIAL was closest in pursuit from inside in the early going, closed in on the backstretch, bid two wide on the far turn, took over and put SIR MAXIMUS away in upper stretch, then drew off under hand urging. SIX MAGPIES (IRE) sat well off the pace on the inside, moved closer outside a rival in the middle stages, took aim two wide approaching the stretch, was no match for the winner in the final furlong but was clearly second best. SMOOTH SALUTE tracked in the two path then dropped to mid-pack around the first turn, moved into range leaving the backstretch, loomed three wide turning for home but flattened out in the lane. SIR MAXIMUS broke alertly while shifting out at the start, opened up in the early stages along the inside, held a diminished lead approaching the far turn, took pressure past the three-eighths pole, resisted through the bend, then yielded to the winner in upper stretch and folded in the furlong grounds. BATTLE CRUISER broke out, moved inside and settle in mid-pack, crept closer up the backstretch, ridden along the fence on the far turn and faltered in the stretch run. ANDREADYTORUMBLE was fractious in the gate, backed out, was evaluated and reloaded, raced on the inside near the back, went two then three wide around the far turn and tired down the lane. DAZZLE THE COMMAND threw his head and came away slow, trailed in the two path around the first turn, stayed off the rail to the stretch and never made an impact.

RUNNING SUPER stalked briefly then went up to duel from inside, carried a narrow lead into the turn, lost command battling around the bend, dug in to reclaim the lead with a sixteenth remaining and drove clear. COASTAL COWGIRL brushed outer rival leaving the gate, stepped to the front then dueled outside RUNNING SUPER up the backstretch and around the turn, inched ahead in upper stretch, lost command at the sixteenth pole and yielded late. BLUE FASHION coaxed along in range in the early going, chased two wide then along the rail on the turn, could not summon the needed rally in the stretch but was able to hold third. MAYACAMA stalked the dueling pair alongside BLUE FASHION, took the turn three wide and weakened down the lane. TINY PRANCER brushed with inner rival at the start, trailed off the inside not too far back, went four wide around the bend, three wide into the stretch, drifted out in the lane and failed to menace.

HAPPY cleared the field and crossed over, took pressure from SPECIAL FLOWER on the turn, shook free from that rival midstretch and remained clear to the wire. ACE ACE BABY angled in and settled off the pace, saved ground through the turn, steered out at the top of the lane, drifted inward in the furlong grounds and rallied for second. SEPTEMBER MAGIC stalked from inside, steadied a bit at the three-eighths pole, remained inside to the stretch, finished willingly along the fence and missed second. SPECIAL FLOWER stalked the lone leader outside a rival, bid two wide on the turn, fought to upper stretch, then got turned away past the eighth pole and got edged for the place and show. ANNIE'S JOY raced in range between rivals, followed two then three wide in pursuit on the far turn but weakened down the lane. STRANGE ADDICTION lacked early speed, trailed two wide around the bend, angled out leaving the turn and was never a factor. GEM MINE steadied behind a rival crossing back onto the turf, stalked three deep up the backstretch, went three to four wide around the bend, drifted in a bit in upper stretch and weakened.

 HAPPY SUE established the front quickly, showed the way off the inside under pressure from TONTELLOURWIVES to the outside, cleared that rival midway around the turn, led near the fence into the drive, continued clear into the final sixteenth, grew a bit weary late but was able to secure the victory. MAXIMUN GOLD raced up close on the inside, fell out of range on the turn, crept closer leaving the bend, angled out in upper stretch, lugged out shortly after, launched a late bid, got up for second but could not get by the winner. DONTTELLOURWIVES pressed from outside, chased after HAPPY SUE three then two wide past the five-sixteenths pole, came back on in deep stretch and was gaining to the wire but got edged for the place honors. READYTORISKITALL broke out, chased three deep then off the inside, rounded the bend in the three path, drifted in a bit in the lane and weakened. JOYFUL MISCHIEF bobbed leaving the gate, coaxed along early at the back, traveled along the rail then two wide into the lane, angled out and improved position. SEXZIE hated being hit with kickback and was rank chasing up the backstretch, traveled three wide around the bend, was a bit rank in upper stretch when hit with more kickback and weakened. LIL MISS BEHAVING saved ground off the pace and had little left for the stretch run.

DOUBLE JAB hit the gate to lose a step at the start, challenged from outside and took over from DOUBLE JAB in the early going, cleared that rival at the three-eighths pole, challenged by that rival at the quarter pole, kicked clear again at the top of the lane, drew away to the sixteenth pole and held safely over the runner-up. UNCLE CHILLY was taken in hand early and dropped back to last while moving inside, saved ground through the turn, tipped out a bit into the stretch, had to pause to avoid running up on the heels of a weakening HOT BOX in upper stretch, altered out into the clear, finished well in deep stretch but could not threaten the winner. CHROMEFLASH unhurried in the beginning and moved off the inside, drew closer between rivals, chased two wide around the bend, drifted out a bit in the final furlong and lost second. WINDRIBBON stalked along the inside leaving the backstretch, steadied behind a troubled HOT BOX and got shuffled back on the turn, remained inside to the stretch and lacked a rally. HAVOC settled four deep in the early going, moved into the two path approaching the turn, tipped three wide past the quarter pole and could not rally. HOT BOX away quickly from outside then duelled inside

DOUBLE JAB, got crowded by that rival and steadied at the three-eighths pole, tipped out and re-bid at the quarter pole, failed to sustain the challenge in upper stretch and faded in the furlong grounds. POTITO unhurried in the beginning, moved into range three deep on the backstretch, navigated the turn three to four wide also faded.
