GAZON (GB) sent up shortly after the break to grab control, set uncontested pace, remained in command into the lane from along the rail and was never threatened in final furlong. THE OLD NINE (IRE) tracked pacesetter from the inside, shook loose from WHATS THE BUZZ in upper stretch and chased winner home proving second best. SAND BAGGER settled off the pace, chased two wide or between rivals, came out bit on the turn then four wide into the lane, again between rivals nearing eighth marker and held off rival for third. CRAZY CAVALIER bumped with outside rival leaving the gate, reserved early, was three wide to the bend then three abreast on the turn, entered the stretch five wide, continued on far outside and was denied third. MY HERO bumped at the start, chased off the rail then three deep, came in some on the turn, later found the rail and weakened. WHITE MOUNTAIN was off step slow, rushed up in inside, in bit tight and checked off THE OLD NINE pass five-eighths marker, dropped back inside around the turn and failed to threaten. WHATS THE BUZZ stalked while outside rival into and on the turn, was three wide leaving the bend and also weakened.

ZIMBA WARRIOR content to chased rivals from off the rival into backstretch, continued three or four wide to far turn, roused then advanced quickly from outside, reeled in rivals around that bend, reached front at three-sixteenths markers and cleared. JOINT VENTURE stepped to the front early, relinquished control passing five-eighths marker, angled off the fence later on the backstretch, regained control into second bend, was overtaken by winner into the stretch and was clearly second best. THIRTY FOUR COUPE broke in and bobbled slightly, unhurried from the inside, saved ground, was inside the winner on the second turn, came out slightly into the lane and weakened. NAUVOO stalked three wide to the backstretch, came in slightly, dropped back into and around the last turn and faded. DURAN forced the early issue outside foe, grabbed lead early on the backstretch, secured the rail, was overtaken by JOINT VENTURE pass half-mile marker, dropped back rapidly approaching the stretch, was eased in the lane, eventually crossed the finish line, bled and was transported off the track via equine ambulance.

NOTHING IS FOREVER content to track leaders from off the rail and three wide on the backstretch, angled in at the far turn, roused and moved up, found path two wide and split rivals exiting the last turn, burst to the front, edged away, drifted out some late but safely held. SWEET HELLO settled inside, stalked two wide into the backstretch, came out some then loomed three abreast on the second turn, caught four deep entering the stretch, remained outside in the lane and gained the runner-up honors. SMILE BABY SMILE lightly bumped with inside foe leaving the gate, stepped to the front and secured the rail, briefly lost lead then regained front nearing half-mile marker, hard asked to hold lead on last turn, lost command in upper stretch and weakened bit from along the rail. DANZING FLYER was bit hard to load, grabbed brief lead early on the backstretch, forced the issue into and on the last bend, was three wide and outside the winner into the stretch and also weakened. TIZZY TWISTER lightly bumped with outside foe in opening strides, settled three wide, angled over, saved ground thereafter but faded.

SPEED OF ELON broke outward and brushed with LITTLE DITTY, straightened and settled off the pace while saving ground, gathered momentum near the half and steadily moved up around the final turn, continued inside progress to mid stretch, eased out then altered sharply outward off the heels of the embattled leaders inside the sixteenth pole, straightened and quickened while on his left lead and just got up while ridden out. SHAPOVAL drifted in soon after the break, secured an inside spot and took to early rating, gained in hand near the half and took up a stalking spot, was put to a ride chasing to the inside of a rival past the five sixteenths, eased out with a gain into the stretch, moved up and engaged the leader in mid stretch, dueled while floated out a bit, gained a slim advantage between rivals in deep stretch, finished gamely but just could not fend off the winner's outer surge. ZAGREUS pulled clear early then dropped in to set a rated pace, remained clear under some rating past the five sixteenths, came under a ride soon into the lane, dug in when confronted nearing the eighth pole, dueled inside SHAPOVAL while drifting out in deep stretch and gave way grudgingly. LITTLE DITTY, brushed at the break, stalked outside a rival around the first turn, was under pressure into the far turn, failed to kick on and faltered approaching the stretch.

PRANCINGTHRUPARIS reserved in the early stages, chased while outside TAM'S LITTLE ANGEL, advanced four wide crossing the dirt portion and into the stretch, quickly collared pacesetter and gained slim advantage passing eighth marker, under strong handling in the drive and inched away from inside rival late. PUSHINESS quickly sped to the front, secured the rail and carved out pace down the hill and into the stretch, ceded lead a furlong out then battled gamely to the finish. SNEAKER settled between rivals, gradually angled over and gained rail midway down the hill, continued inside into the stretch, asked for more in upper stretch and was along for third in final yards. MOMENT'S PLEASURE chased while outside LAMPORGHINI down the hillside, shifted out three wide then moved four and five wide into the stretch but failed to menace through the lane. SHOCKING GREY settled just off the pacesetter, tracked leader while outside SNEAKER down the hill, tipped out three wide in upper stretch but weakened bit through the drive. SALTWATER COWBOY broke sharply then secured the rail and cleared into the first turn, rated kindly on the front through the backstretch and final turn, responded when set down entering the lane, quickly widened under solid left handed asking near mid stretch, had his rider switch to the right crop heading the sixteenth pole then maintained a comfortable advantage while kept alert to the final yards. DAMAZIO was deftly guided towards the inner rail leaving the seven eighths, was taken to rate off the pace, gathered momentum under a hustling ride near the five sixteenths, angled four wide for the drive and sustained a grinding run through the final furlong while second best. FIREMAN DAN saved ground around the first turn, eased out a bit then pulled behind rivals leaving the three quarter pole, dropped back under some coaxing into the far turn, angled five wide for the drive and came back on a bit in the final eighth. BRUCKNER showed speed four wide outside rivals into the first turn, dropped in a bit and rated stalking the winner, was put to pressure pursuing near the five sixteenths, failed to go on in mid stretch and faded. LONE SCOUT, three wide the first turn, dropped inside under a ride nearing the lane, came back out but lacked a solid finish. ALWAYS ON CAY vied between runners nearing the first turn then rated back off the leading pair, stalked outside a rival heading to the far turn, was under a solid ride soon after, lacked a kick near the five sixteenths and gave way. DARK MARCUS rated off foes into the first turn, was taken five to six wide for the backstretch run, edged up slightly near the five eighths, failed to go on under pressure leaving the far turn and faded.

BRILLIANTLY sped up outside rivals in the opening furlong then cleared, dropped in to set a brisk pace, opened up after being put to a strong drive in upper stretch then was fully extended to prevail. KITTY MARREN broke well, rated off the pace while saving ground, edged up within herself into the far turn, worked outward for clear a run into the stretch, straightened to be about four wide leaving the three sixteenths, closed sharply through the final sixteenth but could not reel in the winner. INNOVATIVE had speed between runners then bobbled when in a bit close nearing the wire the first time, recovered and moved up past the three quarter pole and stalked the winner, was put to a solid ride chasing into the lane, stayed in touch past mid stretch then lacked the needed finish. TIME TO SHINE broke inward bumping CLOUDY WOMEN, corrected and settled off the pace and outside that rival, gathered some steam past the five sixteenths, worked outward for the final furlong and kept on with interest. FAVOR TO YOU , headstrong behind rivals heading into the first turn, steadied along between rivals from about the three quarter pole to the five eighths, settled better but still caught between runners into the far turn, was under pressure chasing between horses nearing the stretch and came up empty. SENSATIONAL DREAM was sent to early contention, rated off the leaders into the first turn then dropped inside, moved up nearing the half, was under a ride leaving the three eighths, stayed in touch to mid stretch then failed to follow through in the final sixteenth. CLOUDY WOMEN stumbled a stride or two from the gate then was bumped by an outer foe, regrouped and rated off the pace while saving ground, came out for the drive then failed to kick on. LILA , three wide into the first turn then stalked three deep, was under asking outside

rivals past the five sixteenths, shifted wider for the drive and weakened. DELIGHTFUL LAURA broke a step slow, between rivals and rank early then steadied off heels into the first turn, moved out to four path, pulled a bit early on the backstretch, remained wide through the backstretch run and into the stretch and lacked a response.
