BELLY UP took a short lead three deep early then outside a rival past the half-mile pole, cleared and crossed over on the turn, kicked away in upper stretch, grew weary late but was able to hold. MIO BAMBINO sat off the pace on the inside, hugged the rail to the stretch, moved out and launched a late bid but ran out of ground. BRONKO NAGURSKI brushed with inner rival at the start, lacked early speed, saved ground from off the pace, lacked room briefly behind MIO BAMBINO in upper stretch, gained a clear path and finished well for the show honors. MY RANSOM raced in range two wide into the turn, moved over to the rail, tipped out late on the bend and lacked a bid down the lane. THE KEY IS UNITY tracked out of range three deep, spun four wide into the lane and weakened. NAFTIS showed early foot inside a pair of rivals, chased along the rail then two wide turning for home and weakened down the lane. TALLIS brushed leaving the gate, chased from off the pace between rivals, traveled two wide around the bend before angling out at the quarter pole and failed to respond to urging. NEW YORK DREAMS (GB) raced well off the pace in the opening stages, round the turn four then three wide and failed to menace. HOT LEGS ROMOLO showed speed between rivals then got put in tight at the half-mile pole, chased two wide into the turn, dropped back between rivals around the bend, eased in the stretch and walked off.

GRAY FROST showed the way along the inside under pressure from MORNING ADDICTION, cleared that rival at the five-eighths pole and opened up, held a diminishing lead through the far turn, roused and asked right handed in upper stretch, switched to the left hand midstretch, went back to the right hand late and held the runner-up at bay. DORINE'S WILD CAT unhurried in the beginning, angled to the inside racing at the back, advanced up the backstretch, gained quickly and loomed up while a bit off the rail on the far turn, chased determinedly through the lane but could not summon the needed final kick. VULIN tracked three then two wide outside a rival, dropped out of range, got floated out at the half-mile pole, chased two wide then a bit off the rail into the lane and came up empty in the drive. HOLLYWOOD MISTRESS tracked two wide then found the rail on the first turn, angled out on the backstretch, went three then two wide around the far turn and was never a factor. MORNING ADDICTION pressed the pace from outside, went wrong past the nine-sixteenths pole and was backed out of the race, pulled up early on the far turn and was transported off the track via equine ambulance.

WILL THEN was closest in pursuit from the two path early, saved ground through the far turn next to the fence, tipped out entering the lane, seized command in upper stretch, drove clear in the furlong grounds and was kept busy to the wire. AMORITA sprinted clear quickly racing keenly in hand, traveled in the two path around the first turn, remained unchallenged to the top of the lane, confronted by a pair of rivals and relinquished the lead in upper stretch, stayed on well through the final furlong and held second. TAKE ANOTHER CARD stalked in the two path then moved over to the rail around the clubhouse turn, drew closer near the fence then two wide on the second bend, got moved out by WILL THEN entering the lane, bid three deep in upper stretch but was no match in the late stages. TEQUILAANDTHERAPY reserved along the inside, crept closer on the far turn in the two path, failed to respond to left handed urging in the lane, pulled up late on the clubhouse turn following the race and walked off.

WEGONAHAVAGOODTIME pressed from outside, lost touch with the leader midway around the bend, chased two wide into the lane, came back and latched onto GRAZEN SUN with a sixteenth remaining and got up in the closing moments. GRAZEN SUN sent for the lead from inside and set the pace under pressure, shook free nearing the five-sixteenths pole, continued clear to midstretch, met the challenge from WEGONAHAVAGOODTIME at the sixteenth pole, battled gamely to the wire and was nosed out on the line. NAUVOO stalked the top pair in hand up the backstretch, lost ground on the inside around the bend, churned on down the lane and gained third. SQUARE CAT stalked outside the top pair early, chased in the three path through the turn and weakened. UPSTART YANKEE lagged behind early, trailed four then three wide to the stretch and was outrun.

SPUN NOT STIRRED steadied along the rail behind a rival on the first turn, chased between on the backstretch in mid-pack, ridden along two then three wide on the second bend, reeled in the leader at the eighth pole, led clear into the final sixteenth and was kept busy late. UNCLE EVCO stalked three then two wide around the first turn, was closest in pursuit going into the second bend, remained two to the stretch, finished willingly down the lane but could not match the winner in the late stages. CANO FOR THE WIN fought four deep into the first turn then dueled from outside while moving into the two path, cleared inner rival early on the backstretch, showed the way along the inside to the lane, challenged past the eighth pole and relinquished the lead, then flattened late and lost second. SAWTOOTH BOW showed brief speed inside a trio of rivals then got put in tight and steadied early on the first turn, moved into the two path giving chase, traveled in mid-pack on the backstretch, dropped back three then four wide on the far turn and had little left for the stretch

run.

LESS IS MORE dueled from outside then ceded command while moving from the three path to the two path on the first turn, stalked the top pair up the backstretch, continued two wide through the second bend, chased within striking distance down the stretch but finished evenly late. BIG WHOOSH sat off the pace in the two path, moved into range three deep in the middle stages, asked right handed on the far turn, continued three wide to the lane and weakened. EXPRESSIVE LOVE traveled near the back of the pack and moved inside, trailed leaving the backstretch, saved ground to the stretch, moved out in the drive and could not make an impact. BIG CITY MISS stalked the speed from inside, cut the corner into the lane and weakened in the furlong grounds.

NO CAP pressed three deep up the backstretch, chased four the three wide around the bend, challenged BIG POP entering the lane, battled into deep stretch but could not get by the winner. LADY MARYANN chased off the inside, went two wide into the turn, spun four wide into the lane and rallied to get up for third. DORIE MILLER trailed from inside into the turn, drew closer around the bend, put to left handed urging in the lane, could not summon the needed late kick and lost third at the wire. RAISING SILVER dueled for the lead from outside, vied three deep at the five-sixteenths pole, could not kick on with the new leader at the quarter pole, brushed with inner rival entering the stretch and weakened. ROUSING JEWEL dueled from inside, moved into the two path early on the turn, lost command at the five-sixteenths pole, chased the new leader late on the bend, brushed with RAISING SILVER turning for home and folded.

SIMPLEXITY (IRE) stalked from inside, put in a rail bid at the quarter pole, emerged clear in upper stretch and held well over closing rivals late. MEGA MOON sat off the pace between rivals, got boxed in around the turn, moved out in the lane, rallied between horses and got up for second.

WHATMAKESSAMMYRUN settled four then three deep early, chased three wide through the turn, angled out into the lane, closed well and kept gaining on the winner while getting edged for second at the wire. DON'T SWEAR DAVE raced outside the pacesetter early, lost touched briefly then bid three deep with a quarter mile remaining, could not keep up with the winner in upper stretch, continued within striking distance in the furlong grounds but could not summon the needed late kick. COUNT OF AMAZONIA (IRE) settled inside rivals, drew closer while saving ground around the bend, cut the corner into the lane, finished willingly but needed more late. HACKING IT UP broke well then took a stalking position between rivals, rounded the bend in the two path and finished evenly late. MY SUMMER DREAM sat off the pace while widest of all early, chased outside a rival at the back into the turn, angled out at the top of the stretch and failed to threaten. GYPSY TEARS got squeezed between rivals and steadied early, trailed on the inside into the turn, saved ground to the stretch and passed tired rivals. RAGING WATERS stepped to the front and showed the way along the inside into the turn, moved into the two path around the bend, got challenged from both sides at the quarter pole, yielded in upper stretch and weakened. DONCIC stalked outside a pair of rivals in the early going, stayed three wide around the bend and faded.
