HOW ABOUT PAVEL bobbled leaving the gate but was still away quickest, cleared and crossed over, controlled the pace from inside, roused when challenged by MISO PHANSY leaving the far turn, battled gamely to the wire and prevailed. MISO PHANSY stalked from inside, bumped at the three-eighths pole, tipped to the two path midway around the turn, challenged from outside entering the lane, dueled head to head through the stretch and could not get by the winner. LADY MENDELSSOHN bumped with inner rival leaving the gate, moved into the two path stalking the lone leader, bumped with MISO PHANSY at the three-eighths pole, got moved out to the three path briefly by that rivals midway around the bend, angled to the rail late on the bend and weakened. A FLEET RIDE bumped in the beginning, pulled between rivals then tracked in the two path, followed from the rail leaving the backstretch, tipped two wide approaching the stretch and lacked a rally.

TIGER QUEEN dueled from outside then inched ahead past the half-mile pole, carried a short lead through the turn, shook free at the top of the lane, then drew away under right handed encouragement and steady handling in deep stretch. JUST IS became fractious in the gate, traveled in range outside a rival, went three wide around the bend, finished willingly down the lane to get up for second but failed to reach the winner. WOODBINE WAY also became fractious in the gate, broke alertly then dueled from inside, pressed the winner late on the backstretch and around the turn, could not match strides at the top of the lane, kept on through the final furlong and got edged for second in the final moments. DISCREPANCY was off slow to begin, sat off the pace while moving inside, angled off the fence on the turn, tipped out further into the lane, kept trying in the stretch but needed to find more. ICY MISCHIEF stalked in the two path leaving the backstretch, lost ground under asking on the turn and weakened in the drive. QUEEN OF THE TRACK broke through the gate, got brought around and reloaded, took up briefly when tossing her head at the start, raced out of range off the inside, moved into striking distance four wide on the turn, then faded in the stretch run. CHOLLIMA dropped back early, entered the turn in the two path, eased out a bit further around the bend, drifted out in the lane and failed to threaten.

BEYOND LUCKY stepped to the front and took control of the rail, pressured by CURRENT AFFAIR on the backstretch, lost command dueling with that rival on the far turn, regained the advantage from CURRENT AFFAIR at the eighth pole, put that rival away past the sixteenth marker and held over the runner-up. NAFISA stumbled badly leaving the gate, stalked the top pair from the rail, moved into the two path approaching the quarter pole, angled out further in the drive, put in a late bid but ran out of ground. CURRENT AFFAIR raced keenly in the two path stalking the leader early, moved up to apply pressure from outside on the backstretch, put a head in front dueling on the far turn, gave the lead back to BEYOND LUCKY at the eighth pole, fought into deep stretch and yielded. RUNYON CANYON settled next to the fence, saved ground to the stretch and finished evenly late. CAILIN DANA slipped leaving the gate, trailed on the inside then two wide around the first turn, rounded the far two to three wide, tipped out in the stretch and could not rally. HONKY TONK RHYTHM tracked the speed from the two path, lost positions between rivals on the second bend and tired.

GRACIE'S BIG DAY stalked two wide into the turn then found the rail, tipped out at the top of the lane, drew alongside THIRSTY TRICKSTER at the sixteenth pole and drove past nearing the wire. THIRSTY TRICKSTER pressed three deep up the backstretch, dueled in the three path late on the bend, put CIOPPINA PASADINA away in upper stretch, threatened by the winner at the sixteenth pole and yielded grudgingly late. LIQUID SPIRIT hopped a bit leaving the gate, raced in range widest in the early going, cut in entering the turn, chased two to three wide around the bend and gained third. THIRSTY DESTINY trailed next to the fence into the turn, moved into the two path briefly then came back to the rail on the turn, swung out late on the bend and improved position. CIOPPINA PASADINA dueled from inside up the backstretch, inched ahead on the turn, lost command leaving the bend, yielded in upper stretch and weakened. CYPRUS MOON dueled outside PONDICHERRY up the backstretch and around the turn, shook free in upper stretch and held safely under urging. GIRVIN GAL threw her head and broke slow, moved quickly into stalking position behind the top pair, took the turn two wide, finished willingly down the lane for a clear second but could not threaten the winner. PONDICHERRY dueled from inside to the top of the lane, yielded to the winner shortly after, weakened in the furlong grounds and saved third. READY TO DARE got crowded between rivals early, steadied off heels at the three-eighths pole, put the breaks on again at the five-sixteenths marker, angled to the inside, moved out in the drive and kept on trying only to miss the show honors. HEADSTRONG WAYS tracked along the rail, chased on the inside then two wide around the bend, drifted out at the top of the lane and weakened. GLOBAL CONSORT trailed up the backstretch while steering to the inside, angled out and came four wide into the stretch, tipped out further at the top of the lane and failed to menace. SPANISH CARA (IRE) stalked three deep to the turn, lost ground around the bend and faded. ADA THORNE broke a step slow, raced in range between horses, started to weaken in the two path on the turn and had little left for the drive.

THIRSTY NIC bumped with inner rival prior to the first turn, chased five wide into the bend then steered to the three path, angled to the inside on the far turn, came back out into the lane and improved position. BEVERLY T vied four deep into the first turn then moved into the three path, pressed the pace between rivals in the middle stages, failed to kick on with the leader past the seven-sixteenths pole, chased two wide into the lane and tired. MALTESE FALCON (IRE) stalked the pacesetter from the fence, launched a bid between horses with a quarter mile remaining, took the lead at the eighth pole, led into deep stretch and lasted over a pair of rivals in the closing moments. ZALAMO (FR) tracked from inside, pulled early on the backstretch, saved ground to the stretch, rallied between rivals in deep stretch and missed. COALINGA ROAD steadied a bit behind a rival after crossing back onto the grass early, settled in the two path, moved into range on the far turn, moved out in the drive, came with a late bid four deep but was not enough. EL REY REY stepped to the front racing keenly in hand, controlled the pace to the five-sixteenths pole, challenged by a trio of competitors with a quarter mile remaining, dueled with the winner in upper stretch, lost command a furlong out, stayed on well from the fence but was outfinished for the place and show. NITTI (IRE) moved inside trailing the field, got put in tight and hit the rail first time in upper stretch, went between horses at the half-mile pole, traveled in the two path then angled to the fence late on the far turn, summoned a mild rally but needed to find more. INVIGORATED stalked in the two path, bid three deep at the quarter pole, failed to sustain the challenge in upper stretch and lacked late response. NONE ABOVE THE LAW raced in range two wide, bid four deep on the far turn but was no match down the lane. BLAMETHEGOODTIMES bobbled in tight leaving the turn then began to pull between rivals, saved ground on the fence through both turns, tipped out at the top of the stretch and failed to respond. ESCAPE ARTIST raced outside a rival towards the back, three deep

on the backstretch, chased three then two wide on the far turn and failed to menace.

PRACTICAL DAZZLE tracked in the two path, closed in on the far turn, took over outside the eighth pole, cleared midstretch and remained strong to the wire. GARDEN PARTY pulled the rider along early while moving to the two path, traveled in mid-pack outside a rival on the backstretch, moved into range on the second bend while traveling two then three wide, tipped out in the drive, finished willingly to gain second but failed to threaten the winner. TURKEY BIRD traveled three deep at the back on the first turn, moved a bit closer outside a rival on the backstretch, remained two wide through the far turn with plenty of work left to do, finished well under left handed encouragement down the lane and gained third, then was unsaddled on the backstretch and was transported off the track via equine ambulance. HAVE PATIENCE dueled for a bit inside a rival then made a clear lead on the clubhouse turn, took pressure from SMILING FOREVER at the seven-sixteenths pole, resisted to the top of the lane, then relinquished the lead to PRACTICAL DAZZLE and flattened to fourth in deep stretch. SMILING FOREVER dueled from outside then raced keenly in hand when ceding control to HAVE PATIENCE early, stalked the pacesetter then challenged from outside at the seven-sixteenths pole, fought from the two path through the far turn and upper stretch, then failed to match

strides with the winner past the eighth pole and weakened late. CLUB TEASER settled inside in the middle of the pack, drew closer on the far turn, chased in range to the sixteenth pole but flattened late. COCONUT GIRL sat well off the pace in the early going, traveled two wide on the first turn, saved ground on the second bend, got put in a bit tight approaching the stretch and could not rally. LUCKY C saved ground through both turns and never got involved. DANZIG TIL DAWN bobbed in the beginning, reserved between runners early, saved ground around the far turn, eased in the lane and walked off.
