BROSKI (IRE) established the front along the inside, set all the pace to the stretch, drifted out a bit and took the path of UNRIVALED HERO midstretch, fought into the last sixteenth and yielded grudgingly late. UNRIVALED HERO stalked the pace along the fence, tipped out at the top of the lane, tried to rally between horses past the eighth pole but lost a clear path and steadied, recovered quickly and kept on gamely between the top pair late and missed second. RANK tracked three wide around both turns and failed to produce a bid when called upon. ROWAN AUGUST tracked the speed in the two path then found the rail on the clubhouse turn, continued on the fence into the far turn, shifted back to the two path on the second bend and lacked further response in the lane. WEST IS WEST raced in range from the two path, dropped off the pace traveling between horses, chased two wide then along the rail late on the far turn and could not rally. PRAYER trailed in the two path into the first turn, crept closer three deep on the backstretch, chased two then three wide on the far turn and weakened. SKYQUIST was off a bit slow, unhurried while moving to the inside, trailed into the stretch and was never a factor. FOLLOWING AN INQUIRY, THE STEWARDS RULED IN A MAJORITY DECISION TO DISQUALIFY BROSKI (IRE) FROM SECOND TO THIRD FOR SHIFTING OUT AND TAKING THE PATH OF UNRIVALED HERO MIDSTRETCH, COSTING THAT RIVAL A CHANCE AT A BETTER PLACING.

CANANI stalked the lone speed along the rail inside a rival, was patiently handled through the far turn, gained a clear path at the top of the lane and launched a bid, put a head in front midstretch and drove clear. GOING NOWHERE tracked three wide into the first turn, moved into the two path then tipped back three wide around the bend, continued in those paths on the second bend before angling out with a quarter mile left to run, challenged four deep turning for home, put a head in front in upper stretch, then got outkicked by the winner in the furlong grounds. ANNAN unhurried in the opening stages and moved inside, trailed up the backstretch, saved ground to the lane, finished well down the stretch and almost got up for second. FIGHT BACK trailed in the two path around the first turn, had once beat in the middle stages, gained three, four, then five wide around the far turn, lugged in through the lane but still finished willingly for a minor award. JUST A GRAZE was forwardly placed outside a rival, challenged from outside with three furlongs remaining, gained the lead briefly in upper stretch before being overtaken and weakened in the furlong grounds. SUPERMAZEL stalked three deep around the first turn, raced up close to the outside of the pacesetter up the backstretch, put the pressure on RIGHT HAND RYDER around the far turn, seized control in upper stretch and drew clear in the final sixteenth. RIGHT HAND RYDER cleared quickly and crossed over into the two path, controlled the pace to the far turn, pressured by SUPERMAZEL around the bend, lost command in upper stretch and stayed on well for a clear second. CHIEF JACKSON stalked in the two path, lost ground under asking three then two wide on the far turn, weakened in the lane but managed to hold third. SUPERMAX off slow to begin, lagged behind to the far turn, was on the move around the bend while angling out and came widest into the stretch, closed in fast, reeled in the leader at the sixteenth pole and drove clear. BOWTIE BOYS stalked four then three wide around the first turn, vied three deep past the half-mile pole, dueled past the five-sixteenths marker, kicked clear in upper stretch but got run down while coming out at the sixteenth pole and yielded to the winner. BATTLE CRUISER chased from off the pace four then three wide on the first turn, asked four wide on the second turn, chased within striking distance into the final furlong but finished evenly late. CUPID'S CRUSADER settled along the rail then moved into the two path on the clubhouse turn, moved into range along the fence on the far turn, tipped out approaching the stretch, took aim in upper stretch but flattened in the late stages. PETESOLDFASHIONED stalked the speed in the two path, angled out on the far turn, spun five wide into the lane and never threatened. BIG BET stalked along the fence to the far turn, eased out to the four path on the far turn and lacked further response. TIGER STRENGTH set the pace under pressure along the inside, vied with a pair of rivals past the half-mile pole, dueled midway around the far turn, yielded in upper stretch and folded. SIR MAXIMUS prompted the pace from outside, vied between rivals at the halfway mark, lost touch at the five-sixteenths pole and weakened. SWIFT STEPHAN stumbled leaving the gate, tracked in the three path to the far turn, dropped back and chased five wide turning for home and had little left for the stretch run.

VELOCITY chased from off the pace three deep then outside a rival up the backstretch, went two wide around the turn, tipped out into the lane, rallied under left handed urging and nailed the runner-up at the wire. HALSTYN ROSE raced in range tow wide into the turn, tipped three wide approaching the quarter pole, reached the front with a furlong remaining, came under threat from VELOCITY late and got nailed on the line. SUNGLOW (IRE) showed the way under pressure from a pair of rivals then cleared up the backstretch, showed the way along the inside around the bend, cut the corner into the lane, lost the

advantage at the eighth pole and stayed on well for a clear third. EASTWICK raced up close between rivals then stalked inside, saved ground behind the frontrunner to the stretch and lacked a bid in the furlong grounds. AUNTIE broke a step slow, settled on the inside, chased a bit off the rail into the lane, shifted in and almost made contact with the rail in upper stretch, continued along the fence through the final furlong and failed to threaten. MOTET bobbled leaving the gate, unhurried in the early going, raced two wide into the turn, got bumped between rivals at the five-sixteenths pole, angled to the inside shortly after, steered out in the lane then moved back in and lacked a rally. INTO THE HALL lacked early speed racing towards the rear then trailed up the backstretch, moved to the inside, tipped three wide around the bend and could not make an impact. INSOLENTA pressed the pace three deep then outside the leader for a bit, failed to keep up past the half-mile pole, followed in the two path around the bend and weakened in the drive. INNER FURY (IRE) rubbed the gate at the dispatch, traveled outside a rival at the back early, went three deep into the turn, remained three wide to the stretch and was never a factor. TAHITI ITI chased from off the pace along the inside into the turn, lost her action while bumping with outer rival at the five-sixteenths pole, was eased out of the race, coasted through the lane and walked off. THE STEWARDS REVIEWED THE INCIDENT BETWEEN TAHITI ITI AND MOTET ON THE TURN AND RULED THAT NO ACTION WOULD BE TAKEN.
