SAINT SHELIA dueled from outside, took over at the five-sixteenths pole, put TENACIOUS CANDY away at the quarter pole and stayed clear under left handed urging and steady handling. NEPHELE stalked the top pair from off the rail, followed in the three path around the bend, finished willingly down the stretch but had to settle for second best. REBELEXIS raced widest up the backstretch towards the rear, navigated the turn in the four path, moved into third in upper stretch, could not summon the needed late kick in the late stages and held the show. SIEMPRE NAMAN saved ground at the back, cut the corner into the lane and offered a mild response to pick up a minor award. ROMAN BRONZE sat off the pace up the backstretch, three wide into the turn, moved into the two path then spun three wide into the stretch and failed to rally. WALK DOWN COLGATE raced in range from the fence into the turn, tipped two wide late on the bend and faded down the lane. TENACIOUS CANDY dueled from inside to the five-sixteenths pole, failed to kick on with the winner with a quarter mile remaining and tired in the stretch.

READY TO POUNCE raced up close to the outside of the pacesetter, latched onto that rival leaving the backstretch, took over in upper stretch and maintained a short lead over JOINT VENTURE to the line. JOINT VENTURE stepped to the front and crossed over from the three path to the inside around the first turn, met the bid from READY TO POUNCE at the seven-sixteenths pole, fought along the rail through the turn, lost command outside the eighth pole and stayed on well to secure second. SAQEEL stalked from inside, coaxed along at the half-mile pole then decided to stay in a stalking position leaving the backstretch, waited for room behind the leaders around the far turn, moved out a bit and roused in the lane but finished evenly late. KEEP MOVIN' ON chased in the three path through both turns and weakened in the drive. ROYAL 'N RANDO hopped slightly at the start, trailed along the inside, went two wide into the drive and came up empty.

WHITE MOUNTAIN showed early speed between rivals then stalked the top pair off the inside, bid three wide outside the leader at the quarter pole, kicked clear in upper stretch and drew off. SILVER N BLACK settled inside, moved into range on the backstretch, lacked room and suffered a mild shuffle on the far turn before shifting around a rival, tried to launch a bid up the rail into the lane but got put in tight and checked at the three-sixteenths pole, then altered out and finished gamely to the earn second. THE GYPSY COWBOY settled three wide then between rivals in the two path on the first turn, angled five wide midway around the far turn, moved back in and chased three wide into the lane and gained third. SOUL MUSIC dueled from outside, cleared briefly at the five-sixteenths pole, took pressure from the winner at the quarter pole, bumped with SILVER N BLACK at the top of the lane and yielded to WHITE MOUNTAIN, then weakened in the furlong grounds. TOPPERS WAGER trailed wide into the first turn then angled to the inside, steered back out on the second bend, came four wide into the lane and passed tired rivals. SINFUL KING chased four then three wide around the first turn dropped off the pace, moved into striking distance in the middle stages, rounded the far turn three then four wide and came up empty in the lane. ELEGANT LIFE dueled from inside, failed to keep up at the five-sixteenths pole and started to weaken, trailed into the stretch and tired. THE RIDER ABOARD SILVER N BLACK LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST WHITE MOUNTAIN FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN UPPER STRETCH. THERE WAS ALSO A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INVOLVING THE SAME MATTER. FOLLOWING A REVIEW, THE STEWARDS RULED THAT SILVER N BLACK CAUSED HIS OWN PROBLEMS BY TRYING TO SQUEEZE THROUGH A TIGHT SPOT IN UPPER STRETCH AND WHITE MOUNTAIN WAS NOT AT FAULT SO NO ACTION WOULD BE TAKEN.

DAZZLE THE COMMAND chased two wide into the first turn, eased out to the five path around the bend, moved up close three deep on the backstretch, chased three wide around the far turn, was closest in pursuit down the lane, dug in late and missed. UPDRAFT contested the pace from outside, inched clear on the backstretch, relinquished the lead at the three-eighths pole, yielded at the five-sixteenths pole and churned on down the lane to retain third. LIBERTY WOLF stalked along the inside then moved into the two path, coaxed along up the backstretch, dropped back on the far turn, chased between rivals in upper stretch and improved position. KING STEPHEN sat off the pace off the rail, angled in for the turn, shifted to the two path at the quarter pole, tipped out at the top of the lane, closed in fast under right handed urging, switched to the left hand for the last sixteenth, reeled in the top pair late and drove clear near the wire. WAR TO REMEMBER broke alertly to take the front, set the pace along the rail to the stretch, responded when challenged by HELICITY in the lane, drifted out and bumped that rival midstretch, dug in gamely through deep stretch but overhauled by the winner late. HELICITY stalked from inside, bid outside in upper stretch, got bumped by WAR TO REMEMBER midstretch and took a narrow lead, battled through deep stretch and finished a game third. PUBLIC ASSEMBLY stalked between rivals, waited for room around the far turn, tipped out and bid four deep in upper stretch, took over midstretch and drew clear. KENTUCKY GAL (IRE) stalked along the rail through both turns, lacked room behind a wall off rivals in upper stretch, altered out to a clear path and finished gamely for second. MIZZYAAN was closest in pursuit from the two path, moved up to apply pressure on the backstretch, chased two wide through the far turn, re-bid between rivals leaving that bend, led between calls in upper stretch, lost command at the eighth pole and saved third. CHEEKIEST unhurried in the beginning, tucked inside at the back, saved ground through the far turn as well, angled out approaching the stretch, rallied and missed the show honors. PARADISE LAKE raced up close while widest down the hill, stalked three deep to the far turn, bid outside the top pair past the quarter pole, put a head in front at the eighth pole, fought into deep stretch and yielded late. STARTS NOW showed the way early from inside, took pressure on the backstretch before moving clear again, confronted by a pair of rivals with a quarter mile remaining, lost command in upper stretch, fought back along the fence to the sixteenth pole and yielded late. STRUTTING (GB) got crowded shortly after the start, pulled along the inside first time through

the stretch, around the clubhouse turn and up the backstretch, brushed the rail at the three-eighths pole, angled out at the top of the stretch and finished evenly late. ESMERAY (IRE) raced outside a rival at the back of the field, angled out at the top of the lane and was never a factor.
