GOT SOUL shifted in entering the first turn, saved ground both turns, tracked in behind and inside, found room at the rail to launch a swift bid inside taking the lead a sixteenth out, promptly moved clear and held. DYNODAVE was lightly bumped heading into the first turn, settled last but one, began to advance up the backstretch going outside foes four to five wide on the far turn, bid past the quarter pole drawing nearly even, kept on well to secure the place. THE SHILLELAGH settled mid-pack tucking in three wide, tracked the leaders in behind on the far turn moving out from three to four deep, came out seven wide for the drive, finished well but too late. THREE GEORGES was intent on the lead advancing outside runners into and clearing on the first turn, shifted in to dictate terms inside, was challenged on the far turn, came out a bit for the drive, lacked the needed late kick. IT'S A FACTOR broke a bit awkwardly, trailed, saved some ground on the far turn, rallied through the stretch shifting out to gain some but too late. PRINCE OF DEL MAR bumped with a rival early, raced

on or just off the rail throughout and went evenly. NO POKING AROUND ceded the lead into the first turn and switched out to stalk about two wide, advanced for a mild bid between runners late on the far turn, lacked the needed late kick. VALENTINES CANDY stalked from outside racing three to four wide, made a mild bid to reach contention about the quarter pole, flattened out in the lane. CHECK'S ON THE WAY exchanged bumps early, raced well back about three wide, swung out for the stretch run, was never near enough to threaten.
